

## Beware bank scam run out of Nigeria

Businesses across North America are being solicited through the mail by fraud artists from Nigeria, warns the Better Business Bureau. The crooks claim there is a sum of money, usually in the millions of dollars, that must be transferred to a neutral or foreign account.

For the use of the account over a short period of time, huge payments are promised, also amounting to millions of dollars.

But no funds are deposited. Instead, the accounts are either drained or victims are asked to pay up-front costs associated with moving the money.

"These arrangement are allegedly made in collaboration with" Nigerian officials," stated a press release from the Better Business Bureau in Hamilton. "Current estimates are that North American companies are losing over one billion dollars a year to Nigerian scam artists."
