Milton woman gets royal treatment

Gail Wallace was given the royal treatment recently at the University of Toronto, where she was presented with a very special award from a member of the royal family.

The 26-year-old Milton resident was among 100 young adults across Ontario to receive the Duke of Edinburgh's Gold Award of Achievement from Prince Philip at U of T's Hart House November 5.

The award is part of the Duke of Edinburgh's Award Young Canadians Challenge, founded by Prince Philip 33 years ago to encourage personal development and community involvement among young people.

Three other Milton residents picked up, silver awards; Jennifer Inglis, Barbara Merry and Andrea Poth.

Participants are awarded for attaining personal goals in community service, skills development, physical fitness and expedi-

"He (Prince Philip) presented all 100 of us with our certificates and pins and asked each of us about one segment of the program," said Ms Wallace, a school-age teacher at the Family Place Childcare Centre in Oakville. She told Prince Philip about her community service efforts with the local chapter of the Boy Scouts of Canada. "I was number 98 so by the time they got to me I was pretty nervous.

"We sang God Save the Queen before the presentations and the national anthem afterwards. There was also a formal reception that followed which was really nice!"

The presentation was a long time in coming for Ms Wallace, who began the
