Tradition of giving is vibrant at high school

STAFF AND STUDENTS at Milton District High School are asking local residents to give from the heart during their annual Christmas food drive.

Over 160 students and 30 staff members will help fill the cupboards of Milton's less fortunate this year. Students began canvassing recently, and are collecting non-perishable food items as well as accepting cash donations.

"These students come to us and ask for collection routes, they really want to do this," said MD math teacher Dean Murray, who is coordinating the drive with science instructor Karen Colwell. "Often they'll have had an older brother or sister that has taken part in the drive so they want to get involved themselves."

The end result of the drive, Mr. Murray explained, will be hand-

wrapped food packages for half a dozen different groups in town. He is expecting students to deliver 125 packages to the Salvation Army, 50 to Meals-on-Wheels, 50 to Halton Women's Place, 30 to the Children's

Aid Society and three to Halton Recovery House, as well as 300 smaller packages to Allendale.

"This is a minimum projection, based on what these groups have told us they need," Mr. Murray said. "We

usually find out about needy families in our school and make packages for them as well. Each package includes about three or four days' worth of food and is hand-wrapped with a special Christmas wish inside. Packages include a chicken as well as fruits, bread and baked goods."

Once canvassing is completed, staff and students will do inventory and use the cash donations to buy whatever food items they may be low on. Items that are always in high demand, he explained, are pasta, canned vegetables and peanut butter.

Milton District will also be holding bake sales to raise additional funds, while homerooms will take part in coin collections with the winning class earning a pizza party. "I guess we'll call it the loonie-twoonie contest this year," Mr. Murray said.

Residents are asked to make food or cash donations at their home during canvassing or at Milton District during regular school hours.

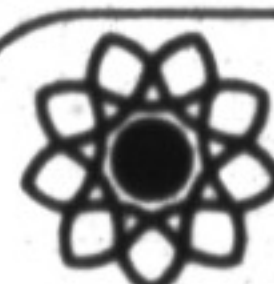
