This allows for the printing of the names that are displayed beside the tree.

The Loving Memory Tree was first displayed in 1991. The pure white lights of the tree offer families a touching and visible way to acknowledge the memories of their loved ones who have died.

Myrna Renshaw, a bereaved parent, states, "Although the holiday season is time for celebration, for some it is quietly

painful. But building traditions of remembrance can help the bereaved reconcile their loss or losses."

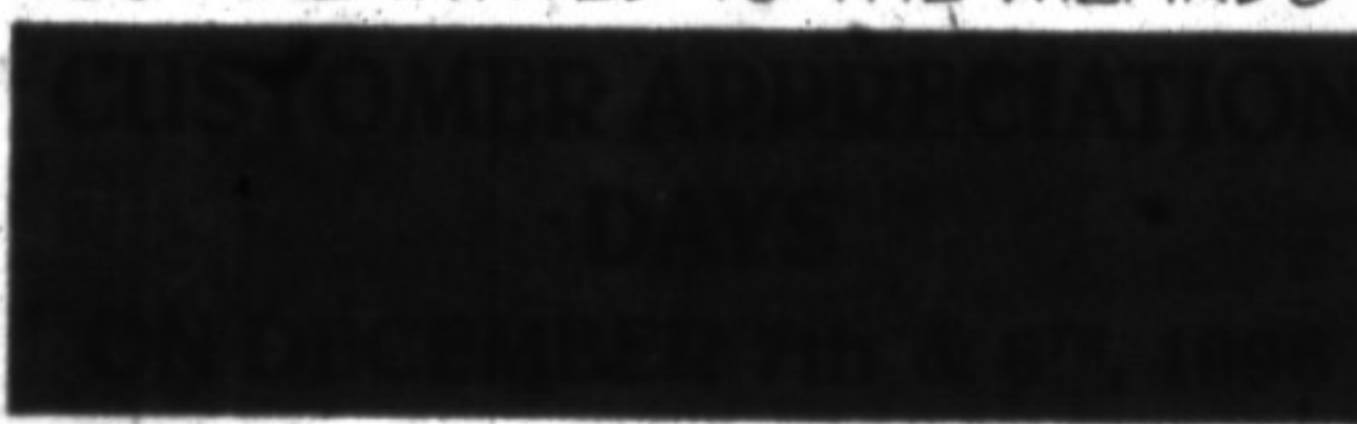
