Posting two new records each were Dimitrov, Andrew Prenter-Duff, Julie Dumencu and Kristin McHroy while Jennifer Claessens, Michelle Claessens, Claire Ishoy, Erynn Mayes, Laura Mayes and David Mondoux set one each. Other strong Milton competitors included Amy Danks and Kendra Miller.

The Marlins will travel up the road to Halton Hills this weekend and compete at meets in Vaughan and Scarborough in December.

Karmax major novices show off with two wins
