drug," said Mr. Chuvalo, whose remaining son is a high school teacher in Toronto. His one daughter manages a restaurant.

Being a teenager today is much harder than when he was young, Mr. Chuvalo said, adding that movies, commercials and the seemingly glamorous lives of addicts like late rock-star Kurt Cobain send a dangerous message to young people.

"I went to a movie once and before it started they had a service announcement about the dangers of cigarettes. As soon as the movie started, John Travolta was puffing away. It's a mystery to me how healthy teenagers can inflict their bodies with cigarettes, alcohol or drugs," he said. "If a can of tomato soup had a warning label that said this can of soup can kill you or this can of soup can cause cancer, of course you wouldn't eat it. Then why do some people do the very same thing with cigarettes?"

While the ex-boxer's life has been mired with tragedy after tragedy, he does manage to remember the positives left — namely his remaining children, grandchildren, new wife Joanne, and the knowledge that he can make a difference in the war against drugs.

"This is my mission now, reaching young people. I hope that anyone thinking about using drugs will stop and think about me and my family before they start," he said.

Mr. Chuvalo is expected to speak at one of the local high schools within the next few months.
