Sweet music for backers of a new and special home

REA SERVICE CLUB MEMBERS are singing the praises of a musician's former home During the mid-1970s, big band leader Mart Kenny of Toronto built his country retreat north of Milton. In the 1980s, the cedar sided two-story estate on 15 Sideroad west of Speyside, with its music room at one

end and indoor pool at the other, was sold to the Basilian Fathers. They used it as a retreat and monastery.

Then, last year, the newly formed Cedarbrook Society, acting on the wishes of its founder Maggie Waligora of Milton, took a leap of faith and put in an offer for the estate, deemed perfect for a respite centre and hospice for chronically ill children. The offer, at less than half of the Basilians' asking price, was accepted.

"It was listed for \$1.5 million," explains Bruce Norman, vice-president of marketing for Special Care People, member of the Rotary Club of Oakville West, and volunteer fundraiser for the Cedarbrook Society.

"The Cedarbrook Society offered \$700,000 and it was accepted. The Basilians took into consideration what the house is to be used for."

Cedarbrook Home is ready to care for two children - the first was expected to arrive before the end of this month. Special Care People of Mississauga is the major corporate sponsor of Cedarbrook Home, explains Mr. Norman. "We've pledged to make an annual contribution over the next five years towards the running of Cedarbrook Home."

Families and caregivers can bring their children to Gedarbrook Home for respite relief totaling two weeks, or hospice care for children who are dying. Up to eight children will be accommodated. "Children will die here," said Ms Waligora, in pointing out the




