## Tory meetings in Halton Hills

The North Halton Progressive Conservative Party is hosting two "Meet the Candidate" evenings. Toronto Transit employee Kulwant Gundu, 57, of Milton, who lost \$36,000, and local obstetrician Dr. Sushil Suppal, who dropped \$120,000.

Mr. Sood, Mr. Toor and Mr. Hans planned to flip the property for \$1 million profit and divide it among themselves, court heard.

The scheme involved selling shares to investors for \$45,000 when the actual price per unit was only \$41,000. Investors were told the complex had sold for \$8 million in 1989, but the actual price was \$7.1 million.

The judge said he simply didn't believe Mr. Toor's evidence, which made him out to be an innocent party "duped" by Mr. Sood. He also called Mr. Sood, the main player in the scheme, "shrewd."

Court heard investors had a chance to sell their shares in the project for \$55,000 in March, 1990, only a few months after buying them for \$45,000, but Mr. Hans wanted to hold out for better offers in the then booming market. After the market crashed, however, the property eventually lapsed into a state of disrepair and was sold by power of sale for about \$3 million in 1994.

Mr. Toor and Mr. Sood return to court April 2 for sentencing.

## Cops on move soon

As of Monday, Jan. 27, Halton Regional Police administrative staff who currently work out of the Georgetown station will be based out of the new district headquarters in Milton.

Inspector Keith Gregory, Detective Sgt. Ron Welsh, who heads the Criminal Investigation Bureau for District One (Milton and Halton Hills), two secretaries, two detectives and

the crime prevention officer will move from Georgetown to the new 20,000 sq. ft. Milton station located just south of Milton Mall.

Insp. Gregory added one full-time clerk position has been transferred to Milton.

Insp. Gregory said 42 police officers will continue to work out of the Georgetown station and he will continue to spend 50 per cent of his time there.
