## Bad start to new year.

A Milton variety store has the dubious distinction of being the first to be targeted for a robbery in 1997, and Crime Stoppers wants it to be among the first holdups to be. solved.

At 3:15 New Year's Day morning, two masked thugs entered the Mac's convenience store on Bronte Street, south of Main Street.

One suspect demanded cash at the point of a gun, while the second went behind the counter and grabbed eigarettes, cash and a variety of lottery tickets. The culprits were last seen running north from the store.

Investigators need help to identify two males of unknown races. The gunman was five-foot-six and his accomplice was shorter. Both were dressed in black clothing, black masks and gloves.
