1975 - Rotorama Carnival was introduced to
the community, raising over \$7000 for
the Credit Valley Treatment Centre.

1977 - Rotary Club of Milton is instrumental in

1994 - In conjunction with other Halton Region
Rotary Clubs the Milton Rotary Club
guarantees a four year financial dona-
tion commitment to the Halton Women's
Place.

1995 - Rotary Club of Milton support the
establishment of the Youth Drop in

Centre on Mill Street.

1996 - Instrumental in conjunction with other
community groups in organizing Milton's
Canada Day Festivities.

1996 - Assist in the organization and running
of the Milton Santa Claus Parade

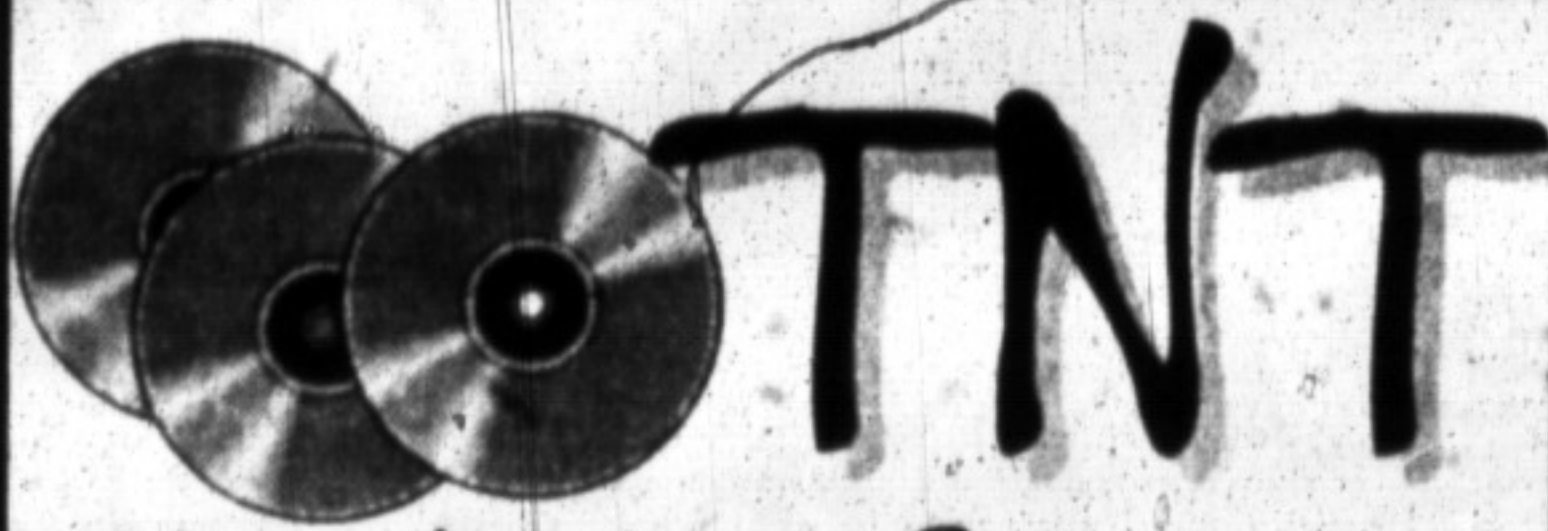
