

SCHEDULE C CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT STUDY NIPISSING ROAD TRAFFIC STUDY NOTICE OF COMPLETION

The recommended solution to deal with a realignment of Nipissing [Road to accommodate future traffic related to the planned expansion of the Milton Mall and the redevelopment of lands along Nipissing Road east of the Mall was approved by Town of Milton Council on February 3, 1997.

The Nipissing Road Traffic Study has indicated that a realignment of Nipissing Road southwesterly to ultimately connect to Ontario St. St. via the present Child's Drive alignment is the preferred alternative... The evaluation of alternatives was based on present and future traffic volumes in relation to social/cultural and economic factors.

Council's recommendation also endorsed an interim solution

where Nipissing Road would "T" into Child's Drive. No timetable has been established for the start of construction.

The Town of Milton is planning this project under Schedule C in accordance with the Class Environmental Assessment for Municipal Road Projects. The Nipissing Road Traffic Study has been completed and by this Notice is being placed in the public record for review.




