

Letdowns costly for minor atoms against Georgetown

Third-period letdowns cost the Halton Lift Truck minor atom-AA Winterhawks back-to-back losses to Georgetown — one in the Tri-County playoffs and the other in game one of their first-round OMHA series.

Milton's recent heartbreak hit its boiling point in the dying moments of their Tri-County match with the Raiders. Up 5-3 with under two minutes remaining, the Hawks relinquished their hold with a goal against at 1:34 and the equalizer right at the final buzzer. Scoring for Milton were Evan Burrell, Steve Ellison, Daniel Lynch, Mattie Reed and Jamie Webb.

Where they choked in Tri-County play, the truckers simply went to sleep through the final frame of their initial OMHA confrontation. Milton erased a two-goal deficit in the second and moved ahead early in the third; then folded up like tents and allowed the Raiders four unanswered goals en route to a 6-3 victory.

Lynch tallied twice while Reed rifled in the other. Burrell, Ellison, Nathan Keith and David

Tielemans drew assists.

The Hawks ended up on the winning side of a third-period comeback against the Orangeville Crushers, with a 2-1 decision in their opening Tri-County tilt. Burrell hacked a loose puck past the Crushers' goalie to even the count while Seth Ferguson took a beautiful pass from Kyle Strong and notched the game-winner two minutes later.
