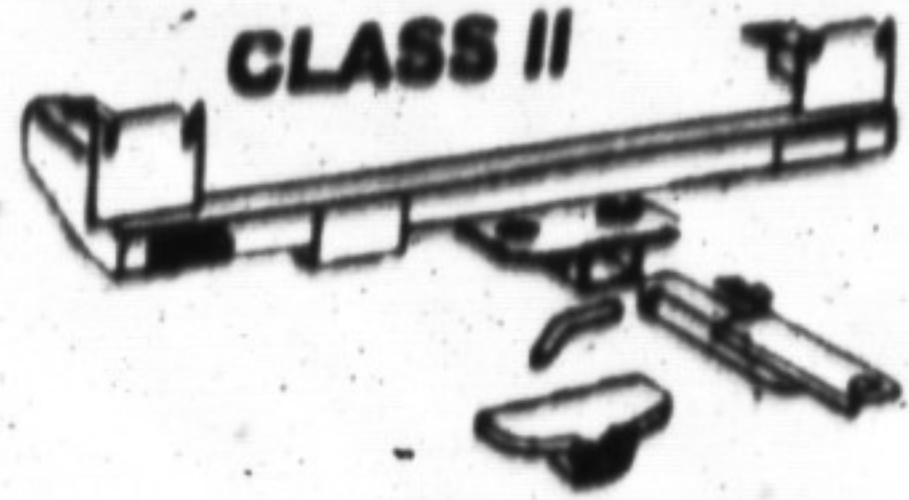

Halton bids farewell to Walter Mulkwich

With political battles left behind by his retirement from government, members of Halton Council commended Burlington mayor Walter Mulkwich for his long public service.

The two-term Burlington mayor and council member in Burlington since 1976 announced this week he would not seek the mayor's job in the autumn municipal election. He cited health problems, saying he would begin chemotherapy in April to fight a form of leukemia.

At Wednesday's council meeting, Mr. Mulkwich slipped out just before his council colleagues

had a chance to say anything struggling for the right words, senior members of council lined up in support of the Burlington mayor.

"While I have crossed swords with him in the past I understand he will not run for re-election," said Milton Mayor Gord Krantz. "I think I speak for everyone in wishing him well in his fight against illness. There is a sense of loss among the 25 of us and our hearts go out to Walter and his family."

Mayor Krantz said Mr. Mulkwich brought a great deal of flare to council, and always acted in the best interests of Burlington and Halton.

Regional chair Joyce Savoline, said there isn't a part of Halton that

doesn't exemplify Mr. Mulkwich's efforts.

"Walter is dignified. He's a statesman and exemplifies what a politician should be," said Halton Hills mayor Marilyn Serjeantson.
