



Centre asks Town for another \$5,000

 "I'll be trying to turn the tide back by offering hope," he said. "Ultimately what destroys their lives is a sense of hopelessness."
 Mr. Elkington said he wants to continue the traditions established by the drop-in but also would like to add programs to its

efforts, such as alternative education and partnerships with groups and businesses in town.
 Councillor John Challinor suggested the group put together a more comprehensive outline of their efforts and future plans.
 Mr. Challinor was skeptical that Milton youth were sleeping in Rotary Park, but

brushed aside a meeting of someone who had when Mr. DeMarsh made the offer.
 "I regularly receive calls about kids who've spent the night in a coffee shop and are looking for a place to sleep the next night," said Mr. DeMarsh.
 Mr. Challinor wanted hard numbers on how many youths are involved at the centre and the hours in which they are served before he would consider forwarding any Town money.

Bob Watson, at council to speak on another matter, side-stepped protocol and encouraged council to offer strong support to the centre and its efforts.

He compared the seniors' centre with the Xcape facility and said he could think of no other organization where money is more needed. Mr. Watson said he prepared a 39-page report on the centre for St. Paul's United Church when they were considering a donation. The report strongly supported the centre's efforts.
