Professional movers can offer clients special cartons and labels for all types of items including special ones with hanging rods designed exclusively for clothing.

Another way to save money is to talk to the company about timing. A move can be less expensive at certain times of the year, during the slow season. If timing is not crucial to your move, there might be significant savings possi-

Remember to discuss all the details and possibilities with your moving company and keep in mind that there's usually room to negotiate an agreement that suits both parties.

The one thing you have to be to save money is flexible. You're entitled to fair consideration and professional service and you should certainly register your objections with the appropriate authorities if your don't get them. It's equally important to remember this is a business for the mover and they are entitled for their fair wage for the service.
