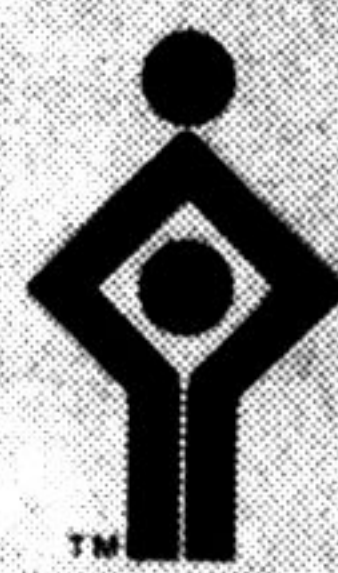

The results of these friendships with lonely children have been remarkable. They have gained a sense of self-esteem, avoided delinquency, done better in school and have generally been better prepared for the responsibilities of adulthood.

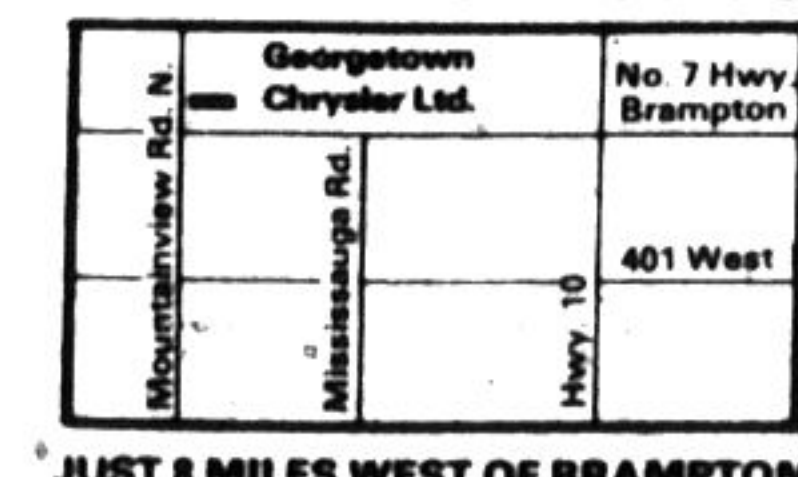
