## Hydro move jolts Julian

Ontario Hydro is "a state within a state" and not answerable to the people of Ontario,

says Halton-Burlington MPP Julian Reed.

Mr. Reed said Ontario Hydro's refusal to allow Petro-Sun to sell electricity from its energy-from-waste proposal directly to Union Carbide in Halton is a classic case, and good reason why the province should change Hydro's mandate. The former Liberal party energy critic for six years, Mr. Reed described Petro-Sun's proposal as an excellent idea and discounted

the argument that both Oakville and Ontario

Hydro would lose revenues from having Union Carbide eliminated as a customer. Mr. Reed said a situation like this would just cause Hydro to adjust its expansion plans at no loss to the ratepayers. This sort of thing would also reduce Hydro's need to go into heavy debt ser-

"That capacity (used by Union Carbide) becomes available for someone else," he But Mr. Reed said under the Power Corporation Act of Ontario, only Ontario Hydro has the jurisdiction in this province to sell electric power.

The blame isn't so much Ontario Hydro's, said Mr. Reed, as it is the provincial government's. "The Ontario Government has refused to assume any responsibility for directing the utility," he said.

Mr. Reed was highly critical of the province's inconsistencies when it comes to energy-from-waste policies. The provincial government's blueprint for waste management policies encourages municipalities to dispose of urban garbage by burning it in energy-from-waste plants, but then doesn't give any direction to Ontario Hydro to do everything it can to accommodate energy-from-waste, Mr.

Ontario Hydro will pay for energy

produced from such plants, but it will not

pay as much as private industry would,

making a proposal to sell to Hydro unat-
