Dakota School class of '15 reunites

Recently, Mrs. Dixon organized a full class reunion of the 1915 class of Dakota School. All five of her classmates are not only still alive, but they're all living within a short 10-minute drive of the school grounds.

"We saw so many of our friends pass away," explains Mrs. Dixon, "but we're all still here. We thought it was something extraordinary and we thought we'd get together and have another school picture taken."

Joining Mrs. Dixon were Gladys Wilson, Eva Edington, Eva Wilson, Burdge Gunby and Sam Newell. All, except Mrs. Edington, have lived their 77 years in the same area. Mrs. Edington lived in Ancaster for a time before moving back to Halton Region.

The old school is still intact although it's no longer used. It was renamed SS No. 10 Nelson (Dakota) and is located on Cedar Springs Rd. south of Britannia Rd.

The six students went through school together and didn't separate until after the eighth grade, known as fourth form then.

Mrs. Dixon recalled the early years of school and their teachers. "Lillian McArthur was our last teacher. She's still living and 88 now."

"Back then, she'd make about \$400 a year. It wasn't unusual for the teacher to spend the evening or overnight at the students' homes talking to the parents about the students."

The six former students all married and raised children. All vowed to meet in the coming years to hold a reunion few other schools on the continent can match.

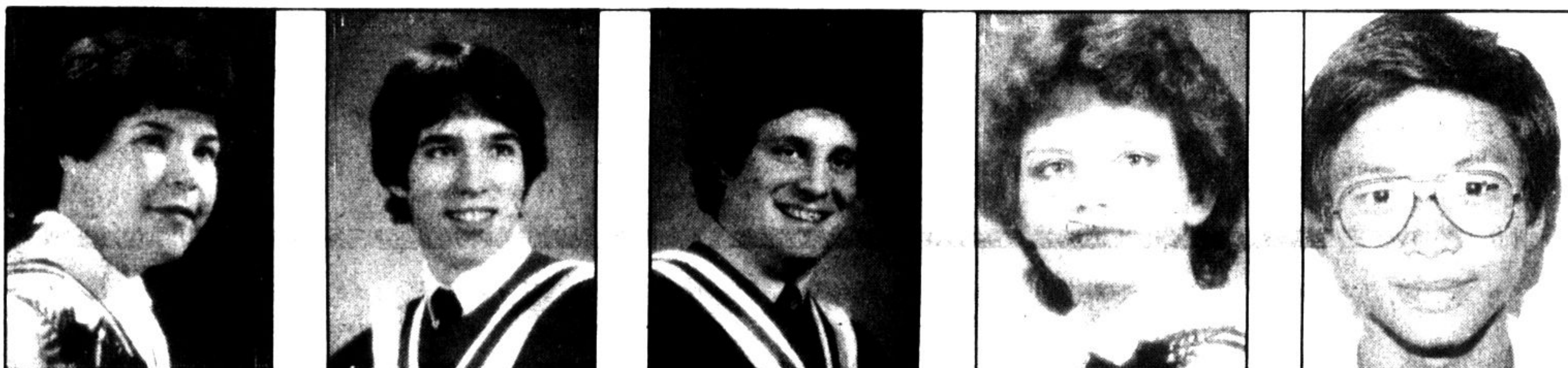

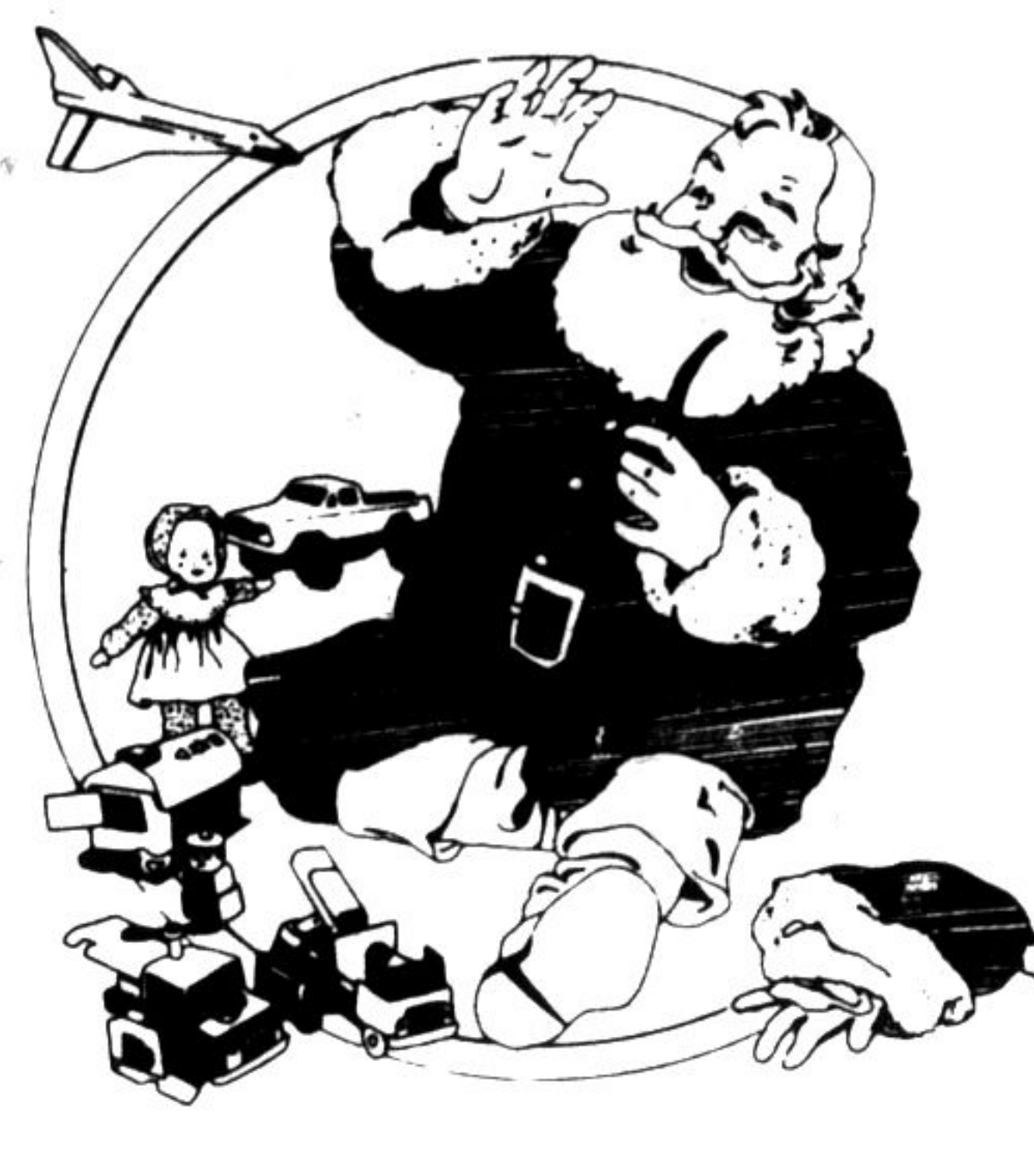

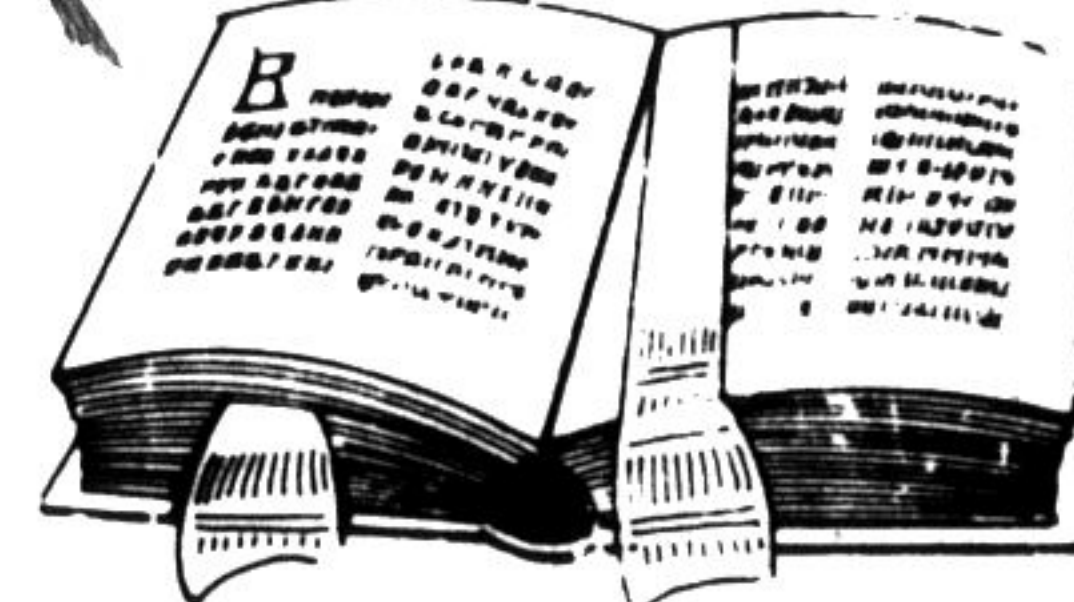
