Help us, in the next two-and-a-half weeks reach \$8,000 and sure everyone in Milton enjoys a truly Merry Christmas!

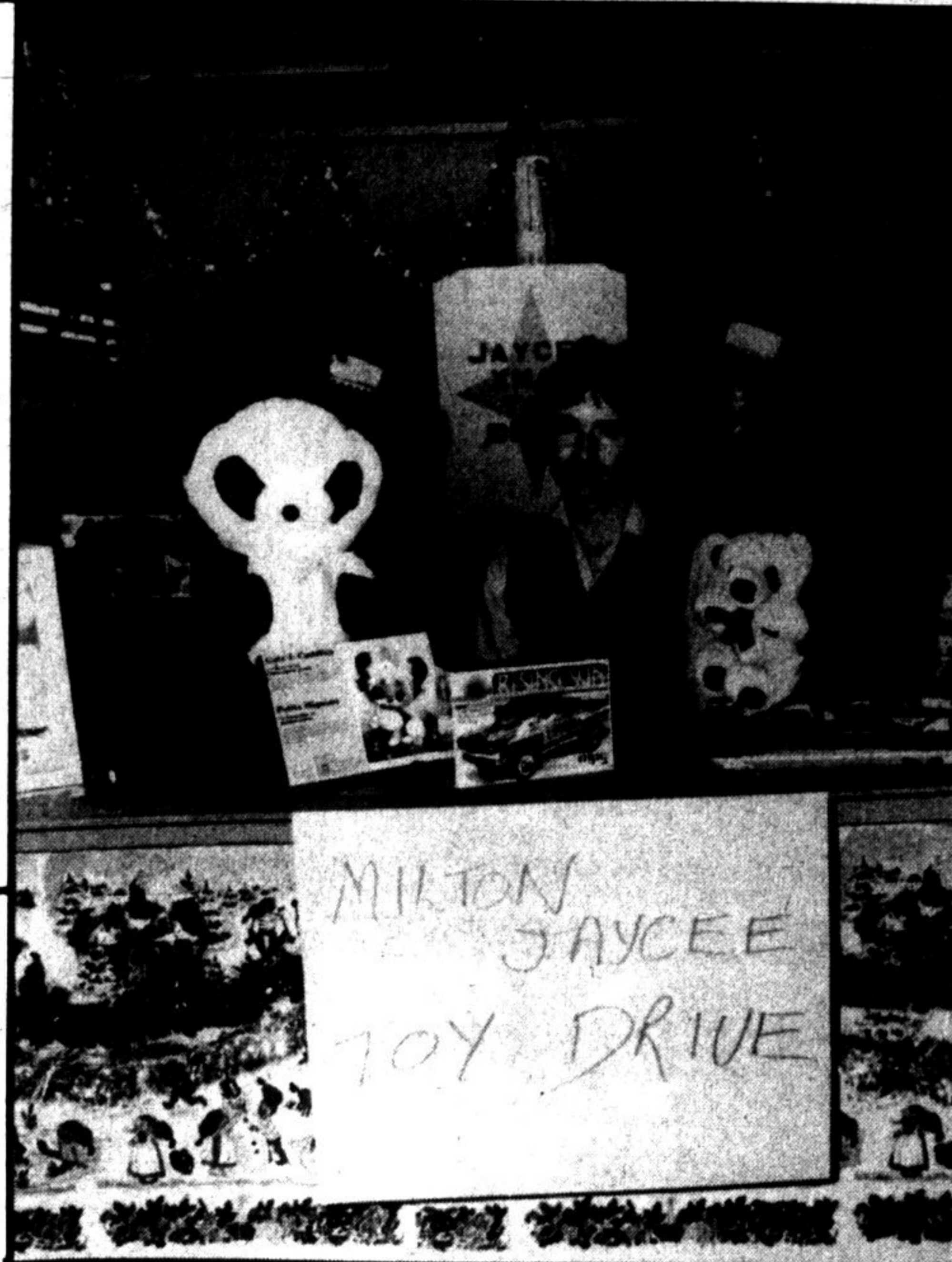
Kids want 'em and we've got two.

Cost could be \$7 million

 Bob Harris, acting superintendent for Maplehurst said the changes will be phased in as the needs arise. But he emphasized, the local institution must be prepared by April 1, 1985 to begin taking new young offenders. Maplehurst will basically serve the area of Metro Toronto and surrounding regions including Niagara, Bradford, Brampton and Barrie.

Sources at the Ministry estimate the new building will likely cost in the area of \$7

million. A final figure has yet to be released. Although that facility will not be completed until 1987, Maplehurst will be offering the same vocational and training services to the young offenders as to the older inmates, but under separate schedules, said Mr. DeGrandis.

Along with Maplehurst, the former Blue Water Centre in Goderich has been selected to look after young offenders in the western district. Two more facilities to serve eastern and northern Ontario are yet to be named.

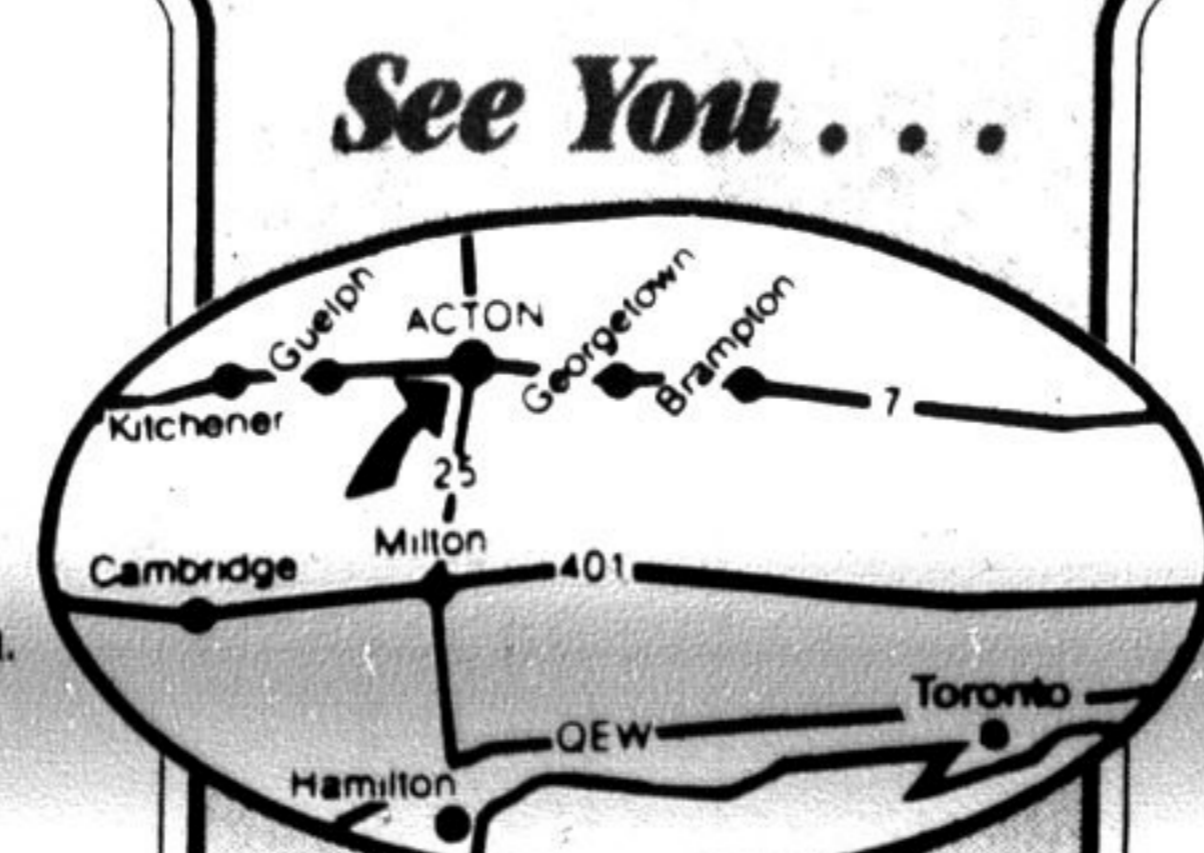
