**Clifford G. Lewington**

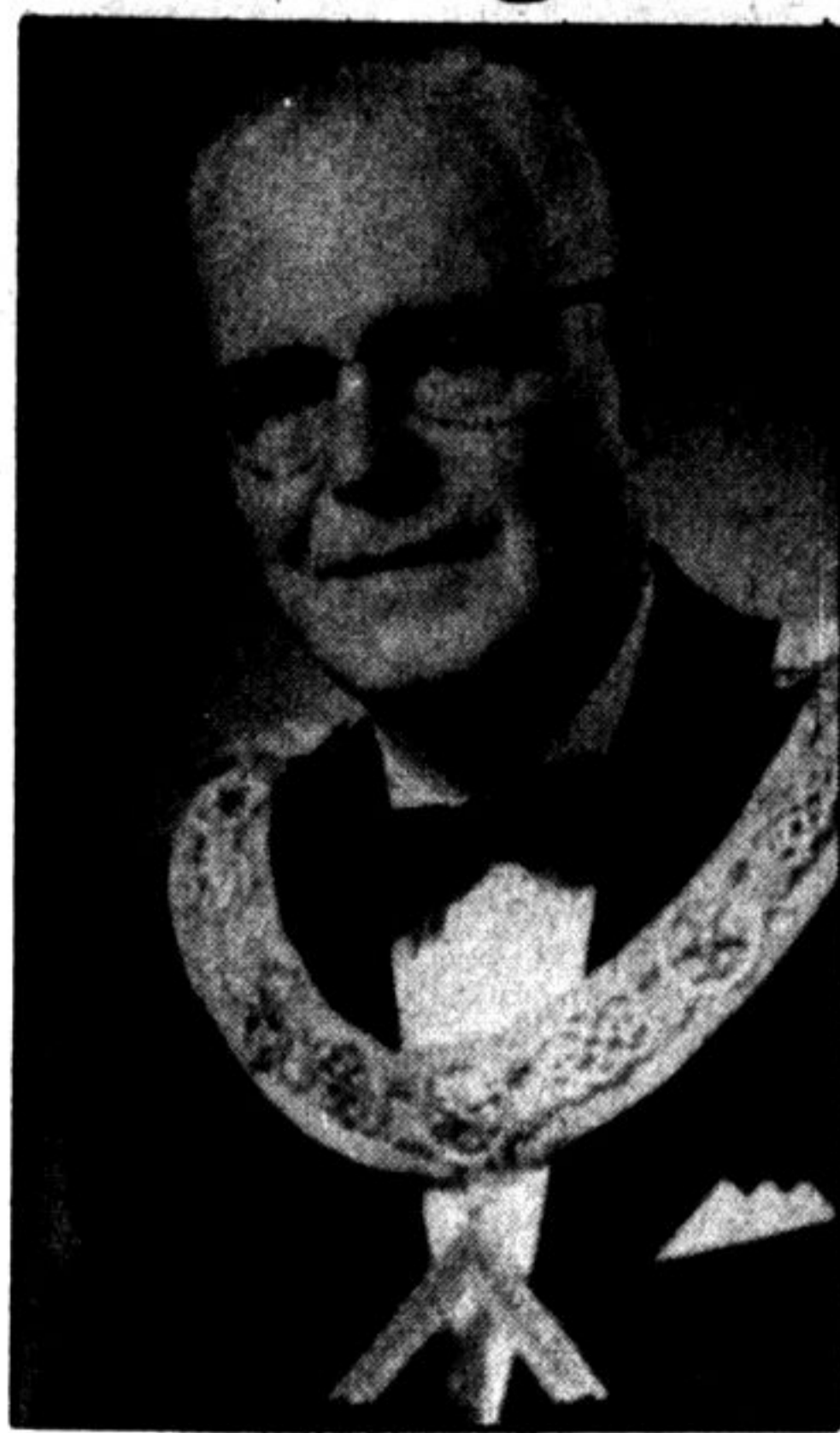
On Fri. Nov. 9, Clifford G. Lewington died suddenly at Joseph Brant Memorial Hospital, Burlington.

Born at Thamesford, Ont. he was the son of the late Charles and Caroline (Neasmith) Lewington. As a boy he moved to Hornby and then to Milton where he attended Bruce Street Public School and Milton High School.

On May 31, 1930 he married the former Jessie W. Kenney and they had two children, Charles and Donna.

For many years he worked at P.L. Robertson Manufacturing Co. then as a letter carrier for the Canada Post. After retirement he served as secretary-treasurer of the Milton Evergreen Cemetery Board and as a clerk in the Provincial Court.

He was active in masonry until his health prevented it, serving as master of St. Clair Lodge No. 135 AF and AM, Grand Superintendent of the Chapter, Member of the Principal's Association, member of Godfrey de Bouillon Preceptory No. 3, and a

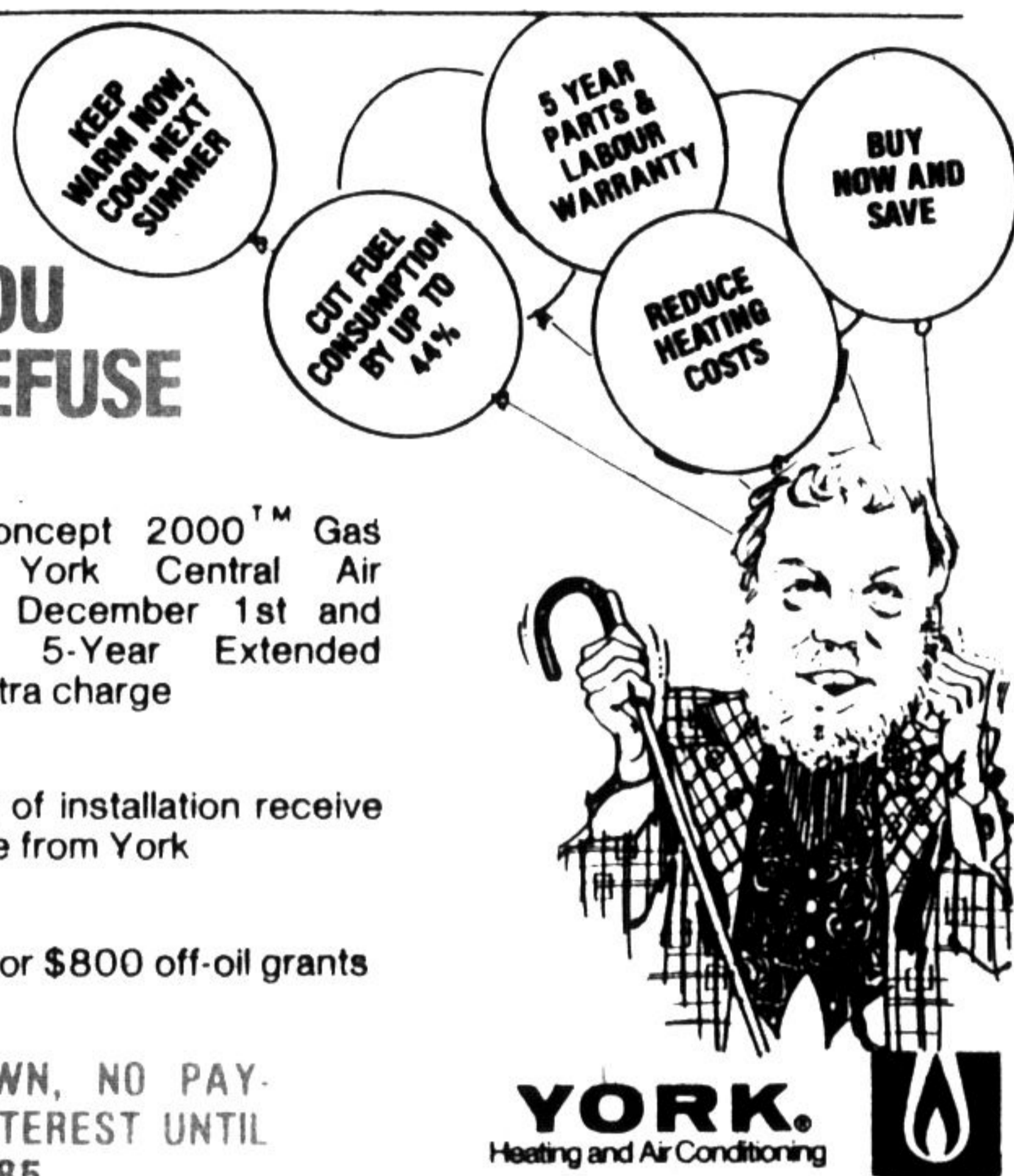
