

Group offers help for the unemployed

Coping with unemployment can be a difficult and demanding task, but a little help from some friends can make it an easier load to bear.

That's the thinking behind a new project being sponsored by a local social worker and the Milton Kinettes Club.

Starting Jan. 26, BOOST, self-help group for the unemployed will start holding regular meetings.

Lead by Elizabeth Kiddle, the group is designed to meet the emotional needs of people who are unemployed and are having trouble finding a new job.

Mrs. Kiddle, who recently faced the prospect of unemployment herself when a Burlington-based family counselling agency closed its Milton office, sold the BOOST program to the Kinettes as a way of dealing with that problem.

"Everyone knows that to be unemployed is a very demeaning experience at times," she said.

"I felt that myself in December on the realization that my job was ending. It seemed then the creative thing to do was to reach out to other people in the same circumstances."

She approached the Kinettes for support, "because I knew they are always interested in creative and useful community projects."

The actual program for BOOST, she said, is still loose, allowing room for participants to shape activities to suit their needs.

Among the possible activities of BOOST, however, are relaxation programs, sharing job leads, resume preparation role playing to sharpen interview skills and just general encouragement for people who feel defeated

by the system.

"We'll be involved in whatever activities are of paramount interest to the participants," Mrs. Kiddle said. "We'll be doing things for one another which have been proven useful and effective."

"We might even get as far of looking at ourselves on videotape, but all the possibilities depend on the group's interests and needs," she added.
