. . . sought new life

Dream ends in tragedy

Werner Bauer was a successful sales manager of one of the country's finest German bakery shops, but he always dreamed of building a house out in the country and becoming a gentleman farmer.

That dream was shattered early last Tuesday morning when a fiery car crash on Highway 401 claimed the life of 38-year-old Campbellville man.

A resident of the Milton area for the past 10 years, the sales manager of Dimpflemer Bakery of Toronto had moved only last year with his wife Helga and three daughters Beatrice, Sandra and Bianca to a 50-acre farm on Guelph Line near 20 Sideroad.

"His dream was to build another house and have a gentleman's farm," said long time friend Kurt Kohler.

Sports activities in the local community drew the two together. Mr. Werner was a member of the Milton Soccer Referees Association and coached a girls' team in the Milton Youth Soccer Club.

An executive member of the Milton German Club, he also played soccer for the German Club's Schwarz-Weiss soccer team.

"He was well-liked, he was a generous person," said Mr. Kohler.

Werner Bauer immigrated to Canada from Unna, West Germany in 1967, first working in Toronto and later moving to Dorset Park in Milton in 1974.

He was on his way home from a business meeting when the single-car accident occurred at approximately 1.50 a.m. near the Steeles Ave. overpass.

It is not known why the accident occurred, but according to Milton OPP, the 1979 Pontiac left the west-bound lane of the highway, rolled over onto its roof and struck a cement pillar causing the car to burst into flames.

A number of transport truck drivers attempted to extinguish the flames but without success.

Funeral services were held Saturday at Holy Rosary Church with interment at Evergreen Cemetery.

displayed in the trophy cases around the Campbellville track.

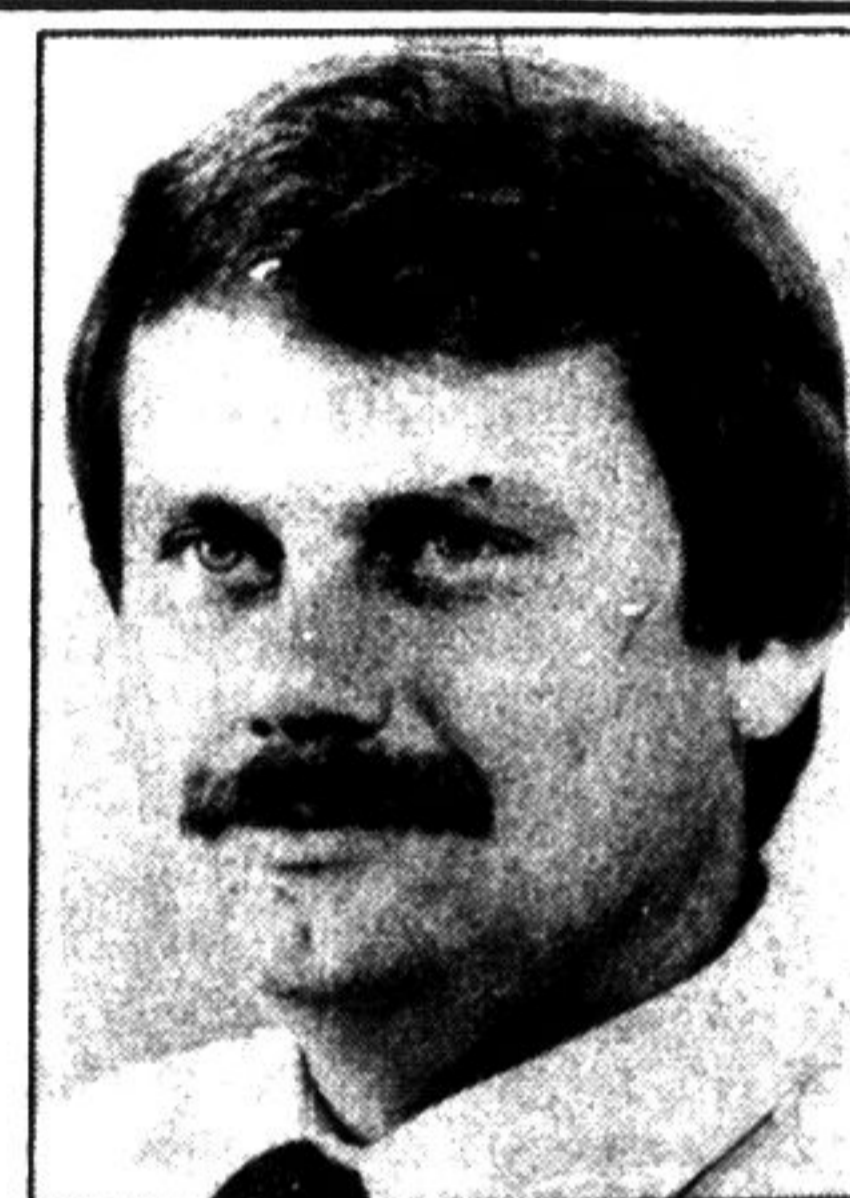

Their \$2,233 is going toward the Lion's total commitment of \$5,000 for the hospital fund.

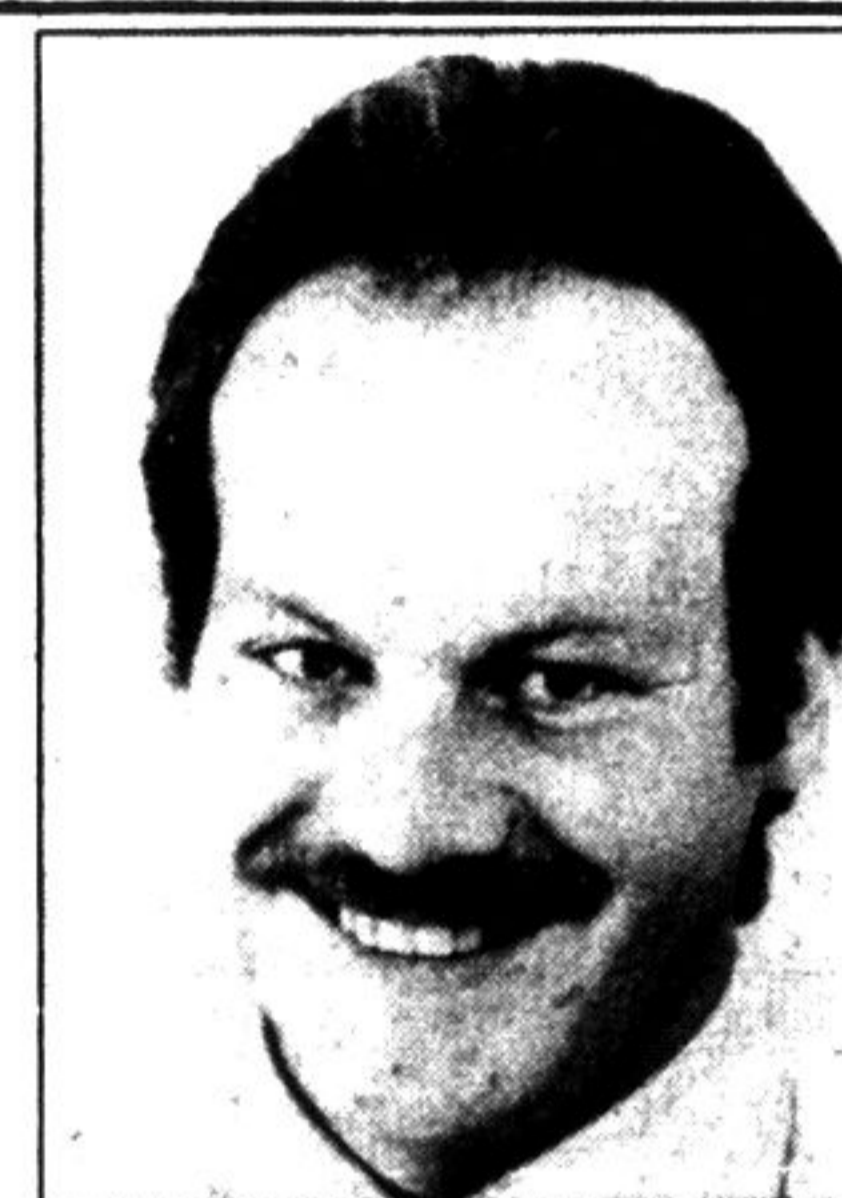
