

Obituary

Dr. G.M. Jamieson

Rev. Dr. Graham M. Jamieson died Friday, May 4, at 1.10 p.m. in Milton District Hospital.

He was born in Newbury, Ontario, the son of Rev. Samuel D. Jamieson and Mary Isabella Graham.

He graduated from Knox College, University of Toronto, with his B.A. and M.A., and was Ordained as Minister of the Presbyterian Church in Beaverton Ontario in 1933 where he served until 1939. In 1939 he accepted the Pastorate in Port Credit where he served until enlistment in the Canadian Army in 1941.

In 1942 he went overseas where he was assigned to the Regina Rifle Regiment. With his unit he landed in the Normandy Beaches on "D" Day in the first assault wave to invade Hitler's Europe and served with his unit through the battles in France, Holland and Germany. For outstanding bravery in action he was awarded the Military Cross.

After the end of the war upon

his return to Canada, he attended Columbia University in New York and graduated with a Ph. D. in Philosophy in 1951. He served as Professor of Philosophy at the University of Toronto until 1952.

In that year he accepted an offer to teach as Professor of Philosophy at Wilson College, Chambersburg, Pa., U.S.A. The following year he was promoted to Chairman and Professor of the Department of Bible and Religion which position he held until his retirement.

After his retirement he and his wife lived in St. Petersburg Beach, Fla., with summer seasons spent at Beaverton Ontario. He made frequent visits to his brother and sister-in-law Dr. and Mrs. Ronald A. MacKay of Milton, where he was visiting when he suffered his final illness.

He leaves his wife Rebecca Fraser Jamieson, of St. Petersburg Beach and his sister Jean Jamieson of Toronto and is predeceased by his brothers Andrew and Duncan.

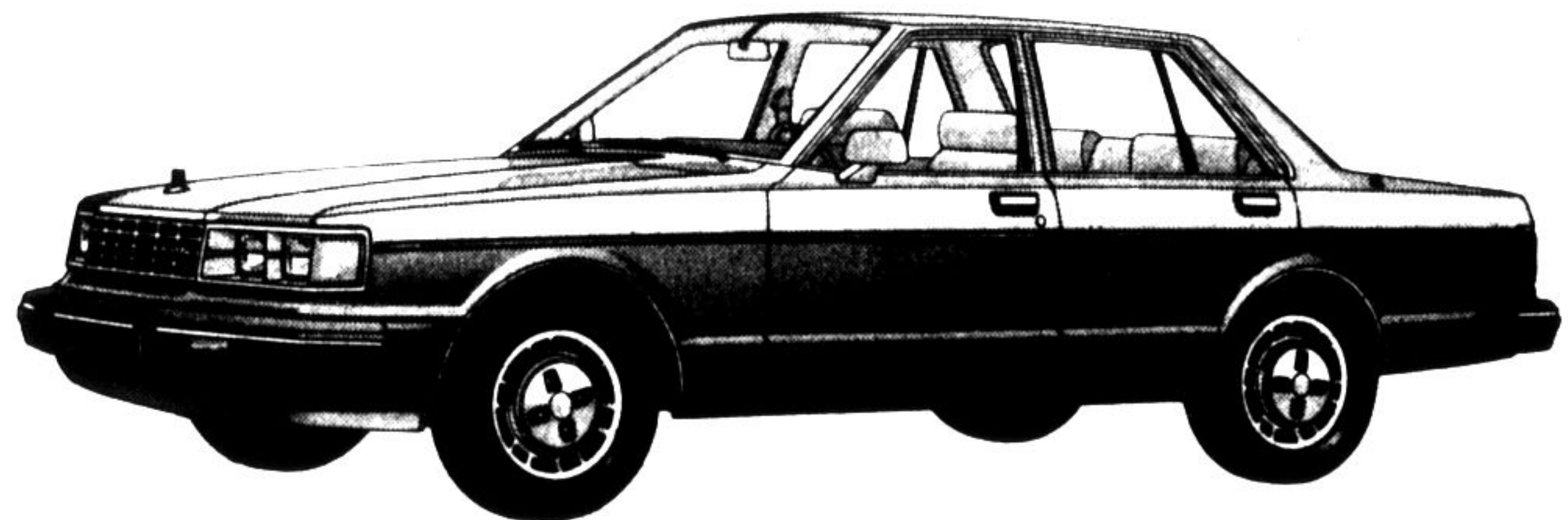

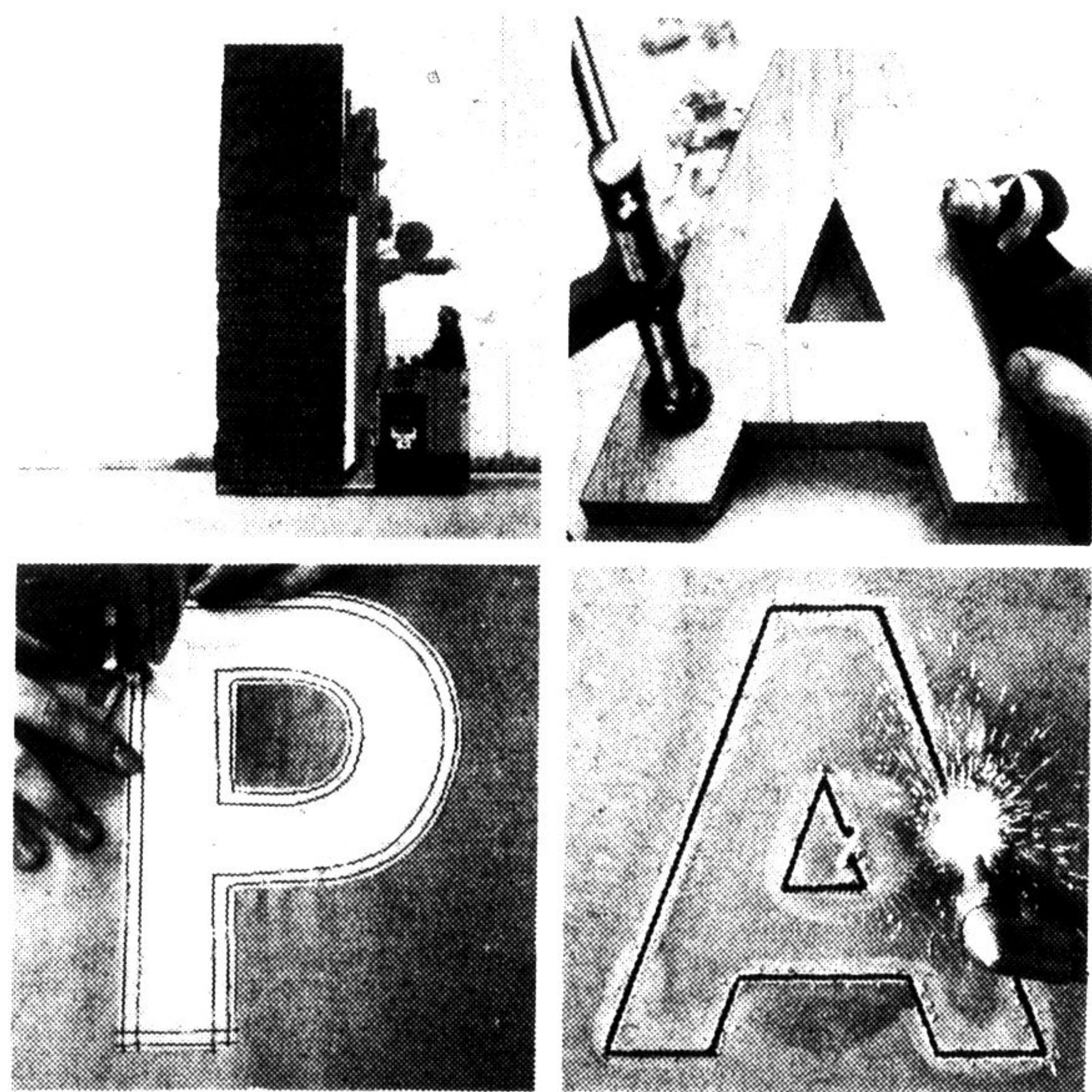
