Advantages provided by this group are felt not only in programs but in terms of school spirit as well.

"When children see their parents here they become more enthusiastic. They know parents support the school and that makes for a good positive attitude," he said.

While teaching staff looked after the food for the luncheon, the Grade 1 and 2 students of Heather Anderson's class took care of the decorating. The children made special placemats complete with thank you messages to the volunteers and tissue paper flower arrangements for the tables set up in the gymnasium.


