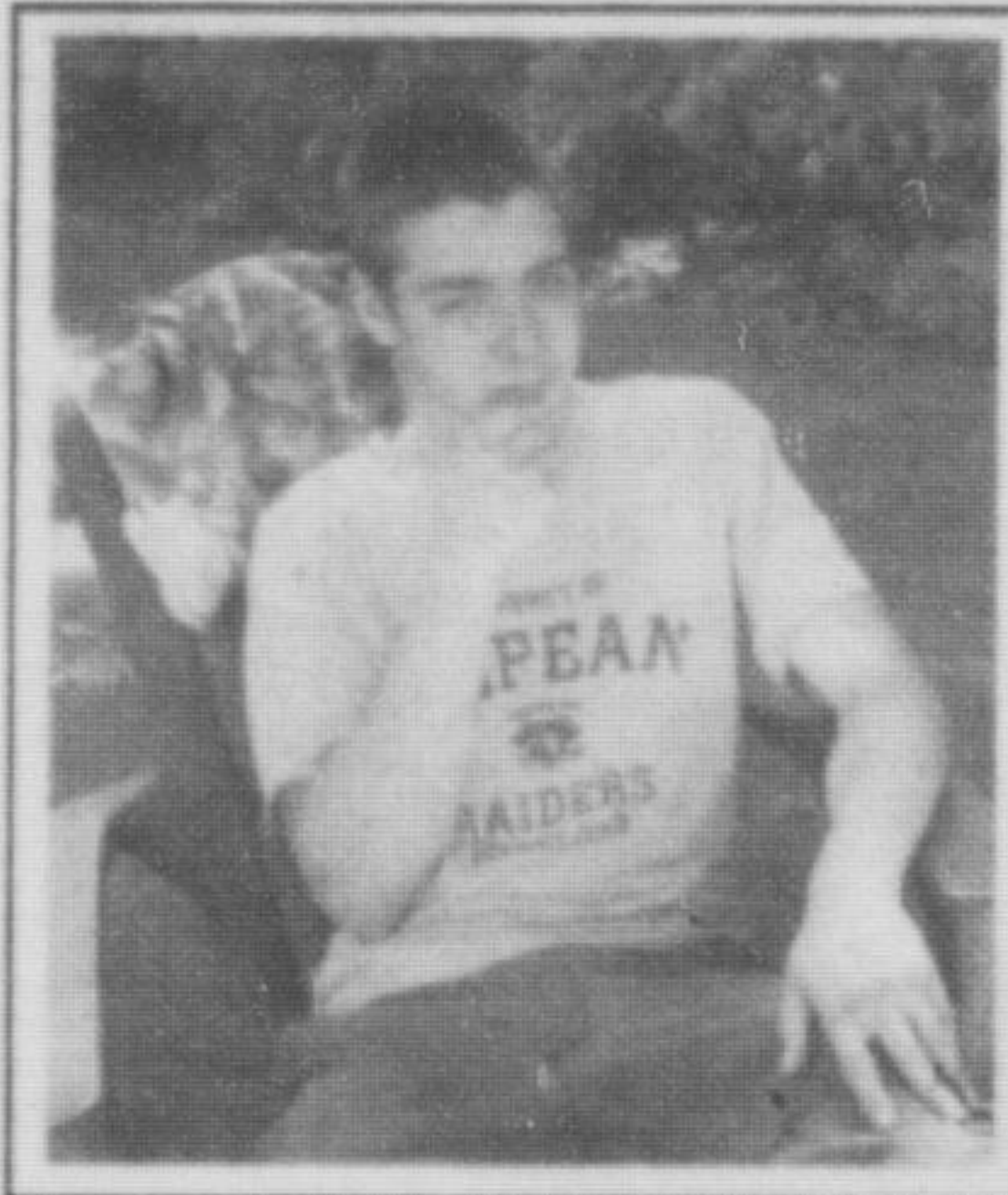

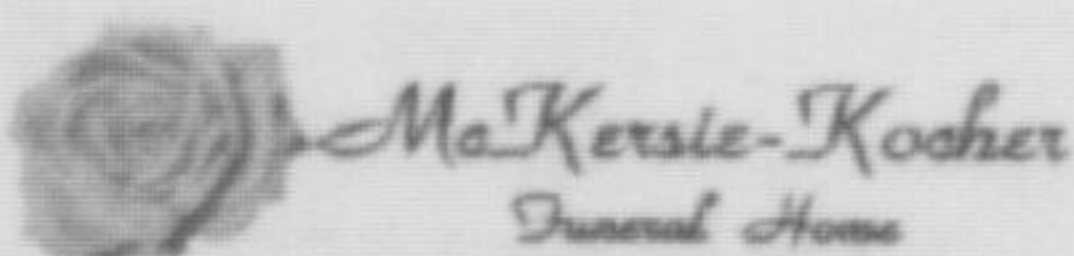


NEWLOVE, David Thomas

Alma May Sykes (Foreman) R.N

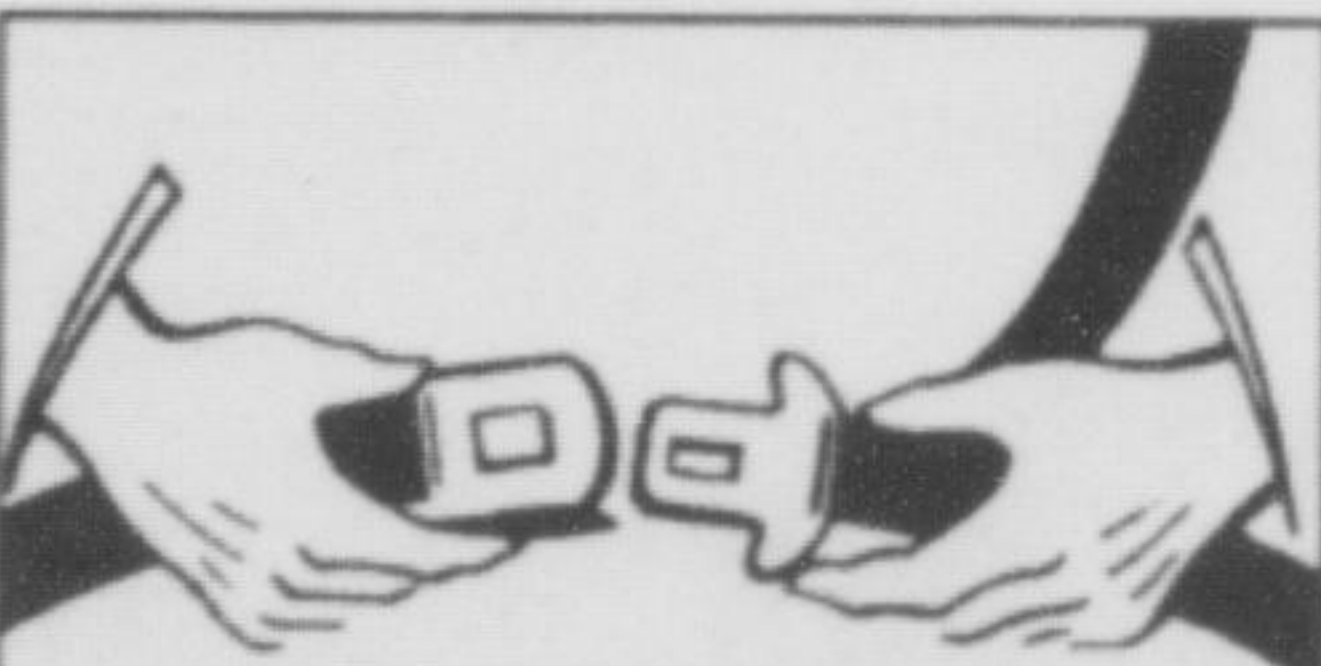
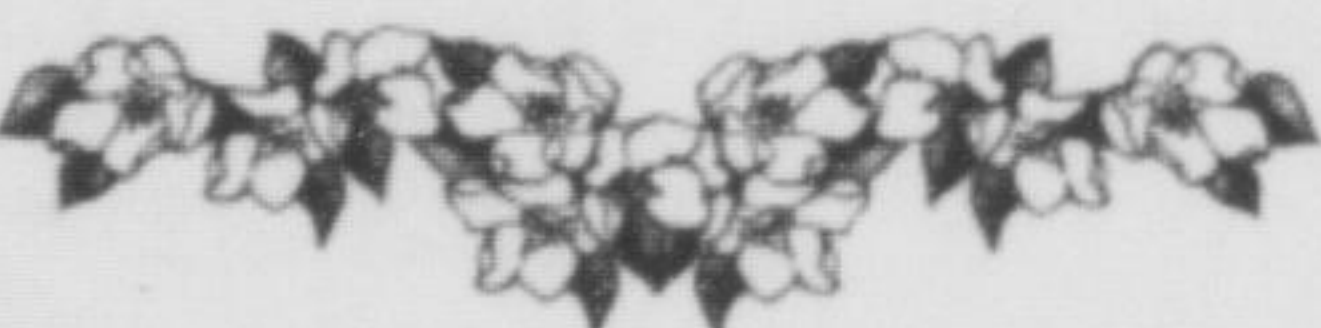

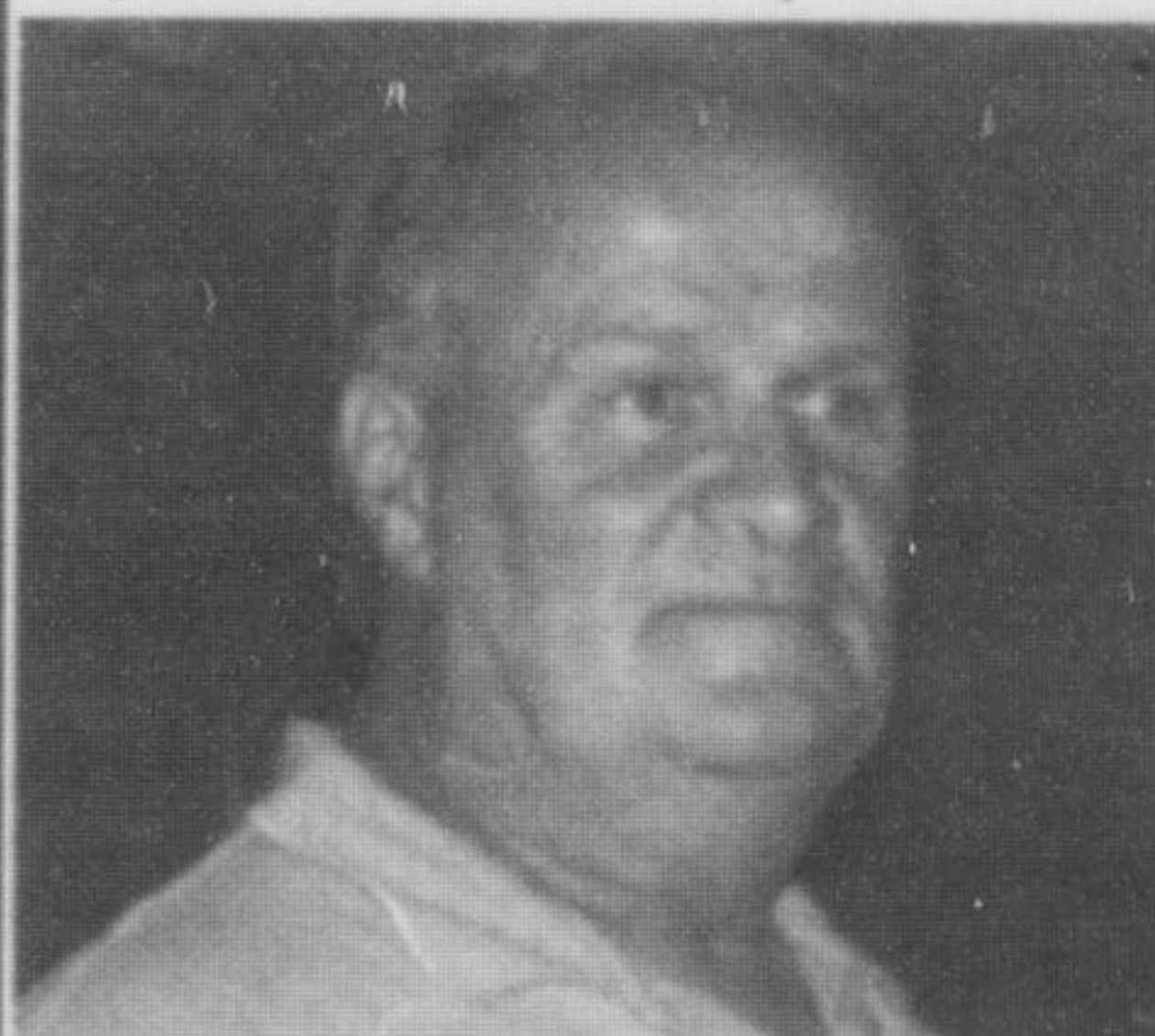
COULSON, John Edgeworth (WW II Veteran)

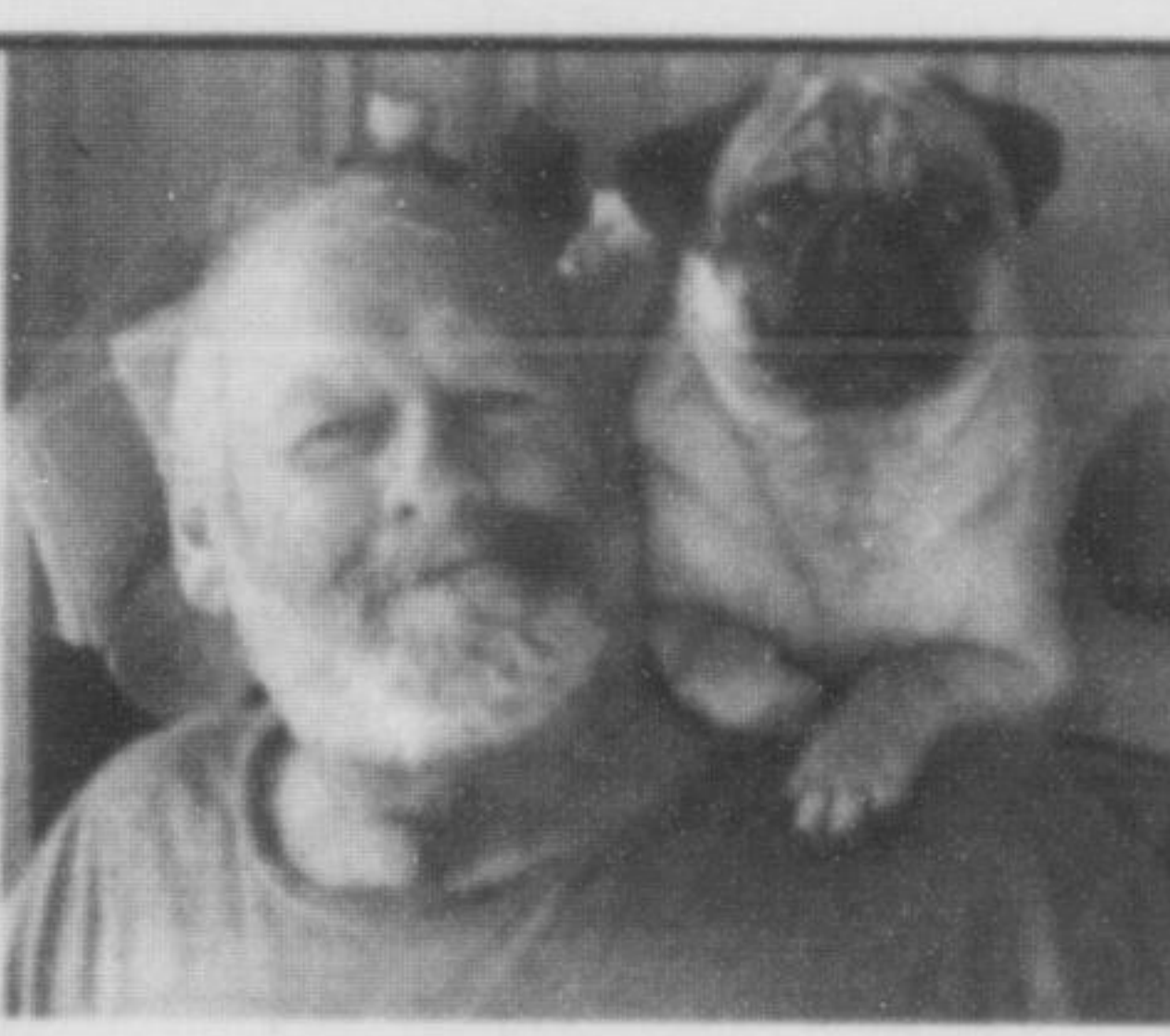


Maria Teresa Pedulla

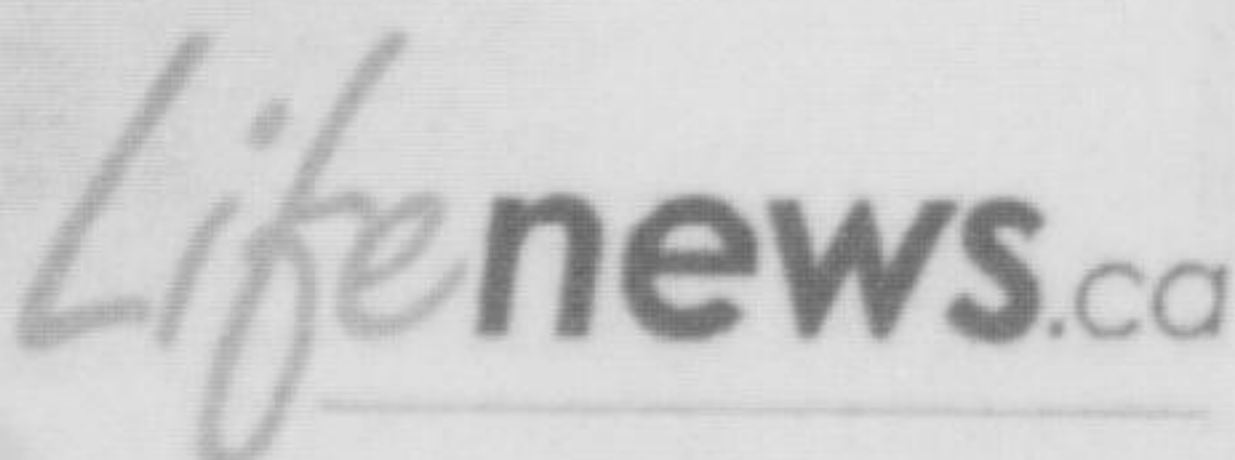
