trusted adult, someone who knows and loves the child unconditionally — a parent.

So I'll not pretend to know what's best for your child and your family, but will suggest that being involved in your community and knowing what services and supports are available is helpful.

Gathering information from trusted sources will help you to be informed about your child's growing abilities, to interpret his or her behaviour and understand his or her needs. Your heart will tell you what feels right and best suits you and your special family.
