Government pledges billions of dollars for new infrastructure

Halton Regional Chair Gary Carr hopes some of the billions of dollars slated in the federal budget to help improve roads, water and wastewater infrastructure in communities across Canada will go toward regional projects like expanding Britannia Road.

He said the Region is looking at expanding the country road that runs from Mississauga to Tremaine Road to a six-lane major arterial road like Dundas Street.

With a development just recently approved for the area near Tremaine, Carr said it would be timely, improving the roads before residents move into the

He added that in surveying Halton residents, transportation and getting around the communities was the number one issue.
