Volunteers to help others in May 4 event

Some 400 volunteers are expected to take part in the 21st annual Milton Good Neighbours Community Day Saturday, May 4.

Volunteers will assist residents who aren't able to perform household and property maintenance tasks by washing windows, digging gardens, planting flowers, raking leaves, cleaning and painting.

Volunteers will also clean riverbeds, parklands and roadsides at 44 Town of Milton-related sites. In past years, they have collected shopping carts, tires, bicycles, a treadmill, a computer and a hot water tank.

The day will commence bright and early with a bacon-on-a-bun breakfast cooked by the Rotary Club of Milton. Most of the food is donated by local businesses.

Volunteers are assigned their tasks and are provided with equipment and supplies such as gloves, cleaning products, paper towels and garbage bags. They're also given a Good Neighbours Community Day t-shirt for both identity and security purposes.

The event is organized by a steering group of six people, with financial support from the Milton Community Fund, Friends of the Environment (TD Canada Trust) as well as in-kind contributions for food and supplies.
