

# Buckley drafted in 15th round by Guelph Storm in OHL Priority Selection

On the heels of a strong season with the Guelph Jr. Storm AAA minor midgets, Liam Buckley was taken in the 15<sup>th</sup> round — 292<sup>nd</sup> overall — by the Guelph Storm in the recent OHL Priority Selection.

He was the only Miltonian drafted this year. A six-foot-one, 158-pound centre, Buckley had 18 goals and 13 assists in 62 games this past season.

This followed a strong 2011/12 campaign in which he helped his hometown AA Winterhawks reach the all-Ontario bantam championships.
