Halton police use of force increases

Halton police used force to get suspects under control more often last year than the one before - according to the service's 2012 Use of Force Statistical Analysis.

The report, discussed during a recent meeting of the Halton Regional Police Service Board, is compiled annually according to the goals and priorities of police training.

The summary looks at many areas, including how many times officers drew and or pointed their firearms, how many times they discharged their firearms, how often officers used empty-hand techniques to restrain suspects and how effective the actions were.

In total, the analysis noted there were 177 use of force incidents reported for 2012 — up from 139 in 2011 and 141 in 2010.

Of the 2012 incidents, 103 involved officers drawing and/or pointing their firearms in the presence of a member of the public (up from 80 incidents in 2011).

An officer is permitted to draw/point or fire their firearm if they have reasonable grounds to believe that doing so is necessary to protect against loss of life or serious bodily harm.

They can also discharge a firearm to call for assistance in a critical situation if there is no reasonable alternative and may open fire to destroy a dangerous animal or one that is injured and suffering.

The report said a service firearm was discharged a total of 21 times during 2012 (down from 23 incidents in 2011).

Two of these incident reports concerned officers involved in the fatal shooting of Kyle Newman on Jan. 12, 2012.

An investigation by Ontario's Special Investigations Unit concluded the two officers acted in self-defense when they shot Newman, who came to the 20 Division Police Station armed with a knife and charged at the officers.
