

## Halton to join west GTA to focus on transit needs

Halton mayors will join counterparts from neighbouring communities in a Western GTA Summit Tuesday.

It'll be held at the Mississauga Convention Centre and will tackle the question, 'Are we facing economic gridlock and what can we do to change the way we live, move, thrive and prosper in the 21st century?'

"It sometimes feels like the western GTA is excluded from the Toronto media frenzy. We would like to make sure we have an opportunity to come together and have a common point of view and a common voice," said Summit Co-chair and Mississauga businessman Brian Crombie.

"We think it is critically important to talk about transit, gridlock, city building — the issues that are going to be the subject of the summit — together and not in isolation. These are regional issues and cross-sector issues. So the idea is these different cities are going to come together, the two regions are going to come together and, very importantly, all different sectors of society are going to come together."

Thrive, Move, Live — The Future of the Western GTA presentation by Urban Strategies principal Joe Berridge will kick off the day. It will be followed by discussion of The Big Move, the Metrolinx transportation plan, the importance of investing in transit and how to pay for it.

Ken Greenburg of Greenburg Consultants will tackle the topic of neighbourhoods, transit nodes and building density in certain areas.

Challenges such as poverty and unemployment rates will be discussed by Liz Weaver of Tamarack — An Institute for Community Engagement. The mayors will be in a panel discussion concerning growth, devel-
