

Cyclist killed in collision

A 57-year-old man was killed while riding his bike on Main Street Monday night.

Police report the cyclist was eastbound on Main Street near Wilson Drive when he was struck from behind at about 9:40 p.m. by a Buick Rendezvous van, driven by a 62-year-old Milton man.

The driver of the van was not injured.

Police officers were nearby and attempted CPR, but the man was pronounced dead at the scene. Police report that alcohol was not a factor and that it was dark and rainy at the time of the collision.


The name of the cyclist — who was reported by his estranged family to have been homeless — will not be released.

This is the first traffic fatality to be investigated by Halton Regional Police's Collision Reconstruction Unit (C.R.U.) this year.

The investigation continues, with the C.R.U. looking at the lighting of the vehicle and bicycle, as well as the conspicuity of the cyclist's clothing.
