

Public funeral for toddler held yesterday at Holy Rosary church

"cant portion of the day." He was a month away from celebrating his second birthday. The toddler was in the care of his grandmother while his father worked and his mother was at an appointment. Autopsy results are consistent with the ongoing police investigation of a child being exposed to extreme heat. Temperatures reached 31 degrees C that day. No charges have been laid at this time as police continue to investigate. A public funeral was held yesterday at Holy Rosary Catholic Church. The child's parents describe their son in a death notice that appeared in the *Toronto Star* as an old soul with a larger-than-life personality.

"He was a boy who loved to talk about birds in the sky and whales in the water," his parents wrote. "He was a boy who would always pick a flower for his parents whenever he saw one. He was also a boy who took the time to say hello to everyone he encountered because he knew how important it was to put a smile on somebody's face." They wrote of his unconditional love, caring spirit and infectious laugh that will be sadly missed by everyone. 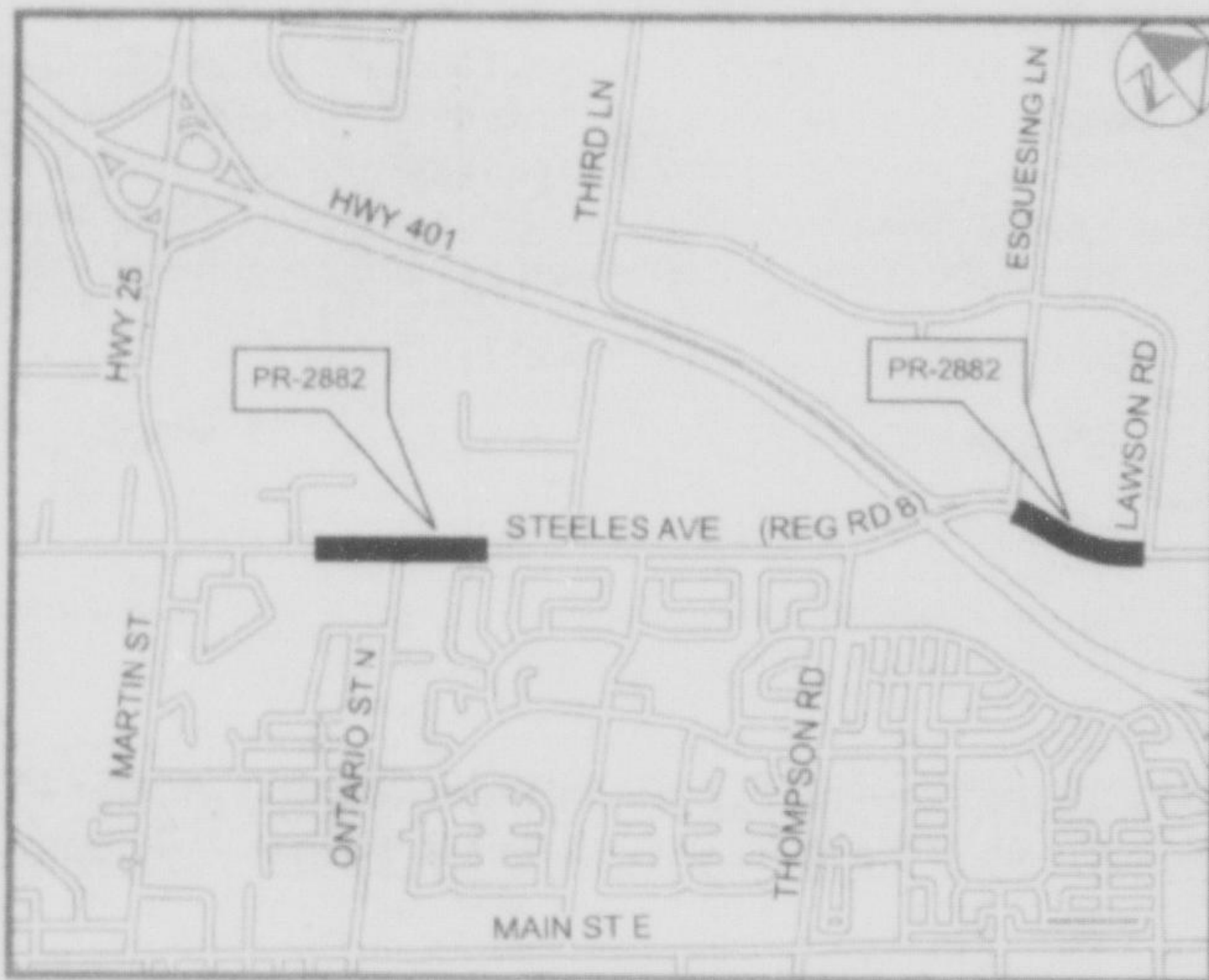

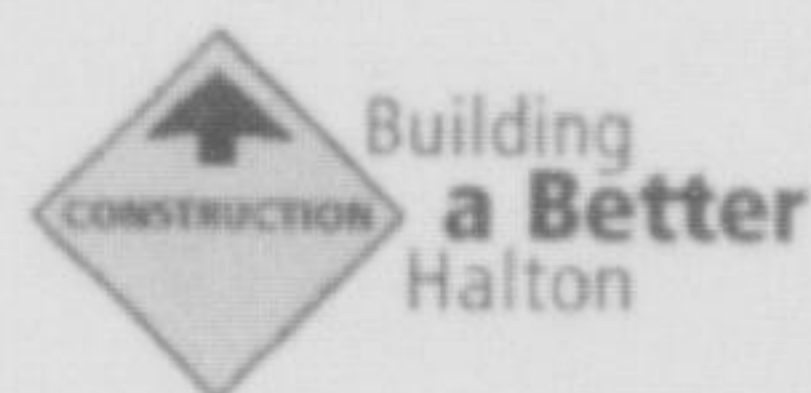

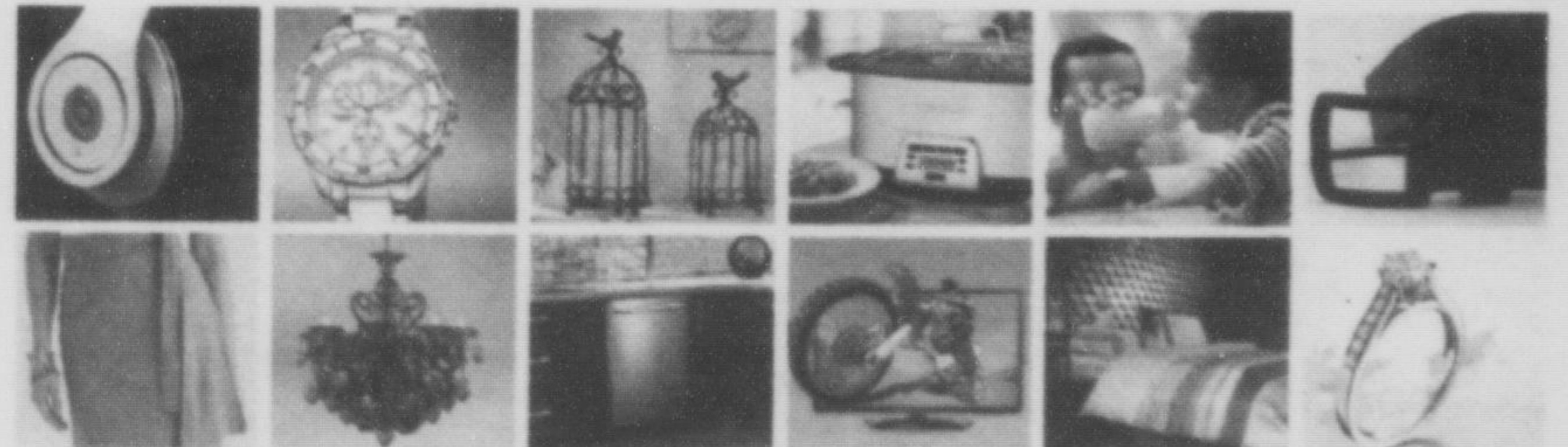
