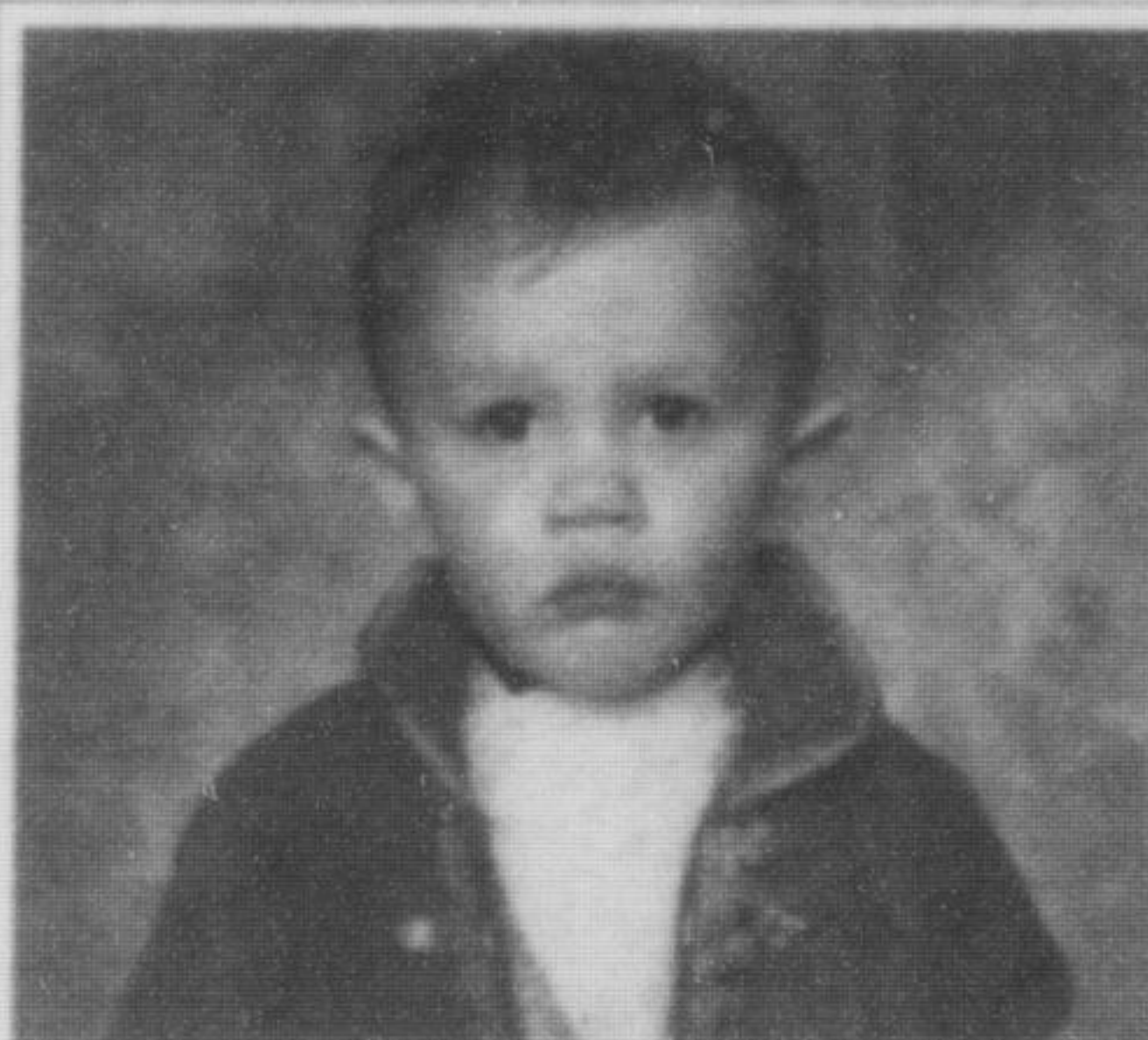
LAROCHE, Muriel

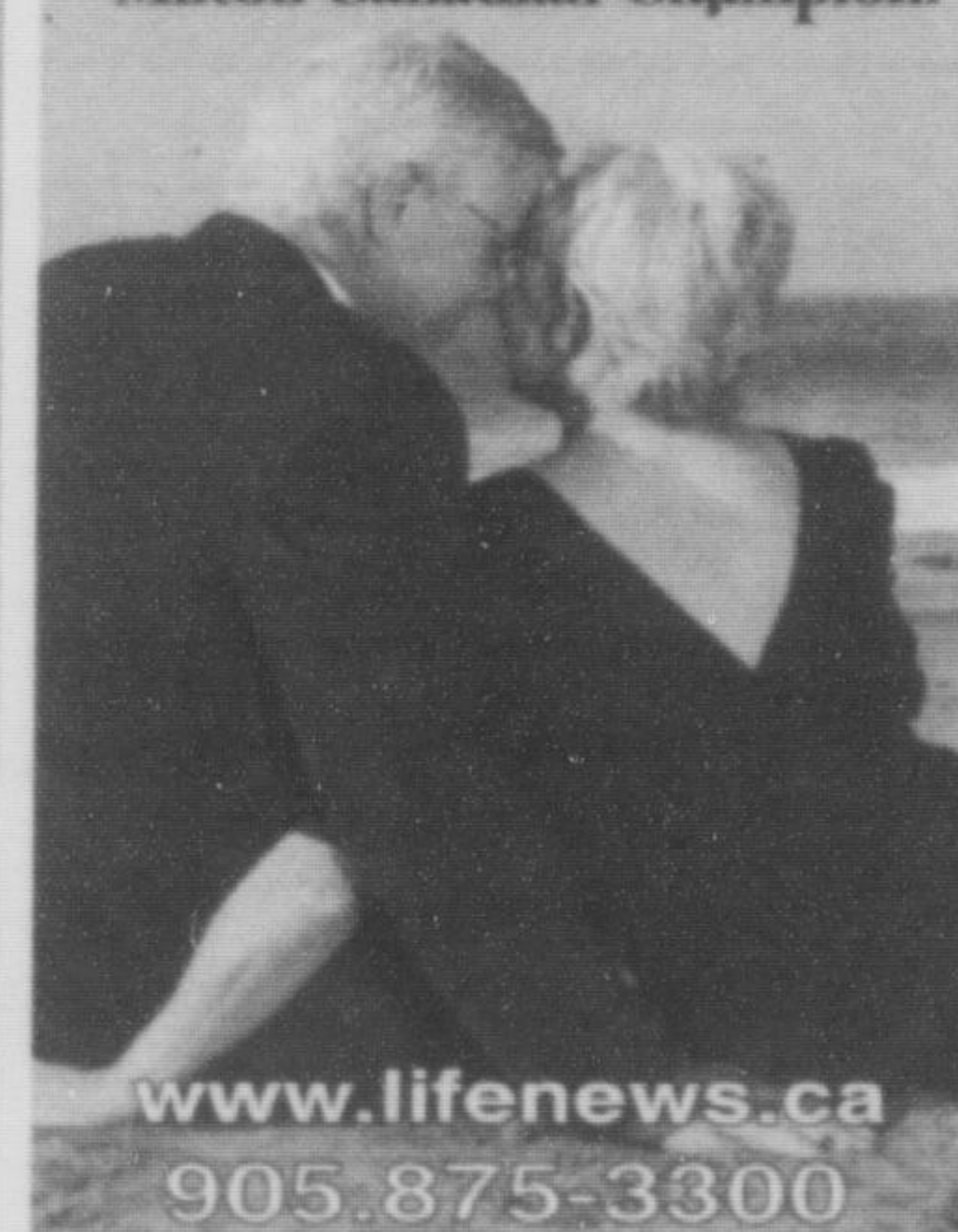
