Nonna may have trouble pronouncing the names of her Canadian grandchildren, but she's always on hand to dispense advice on everything from their careers to their love lives.

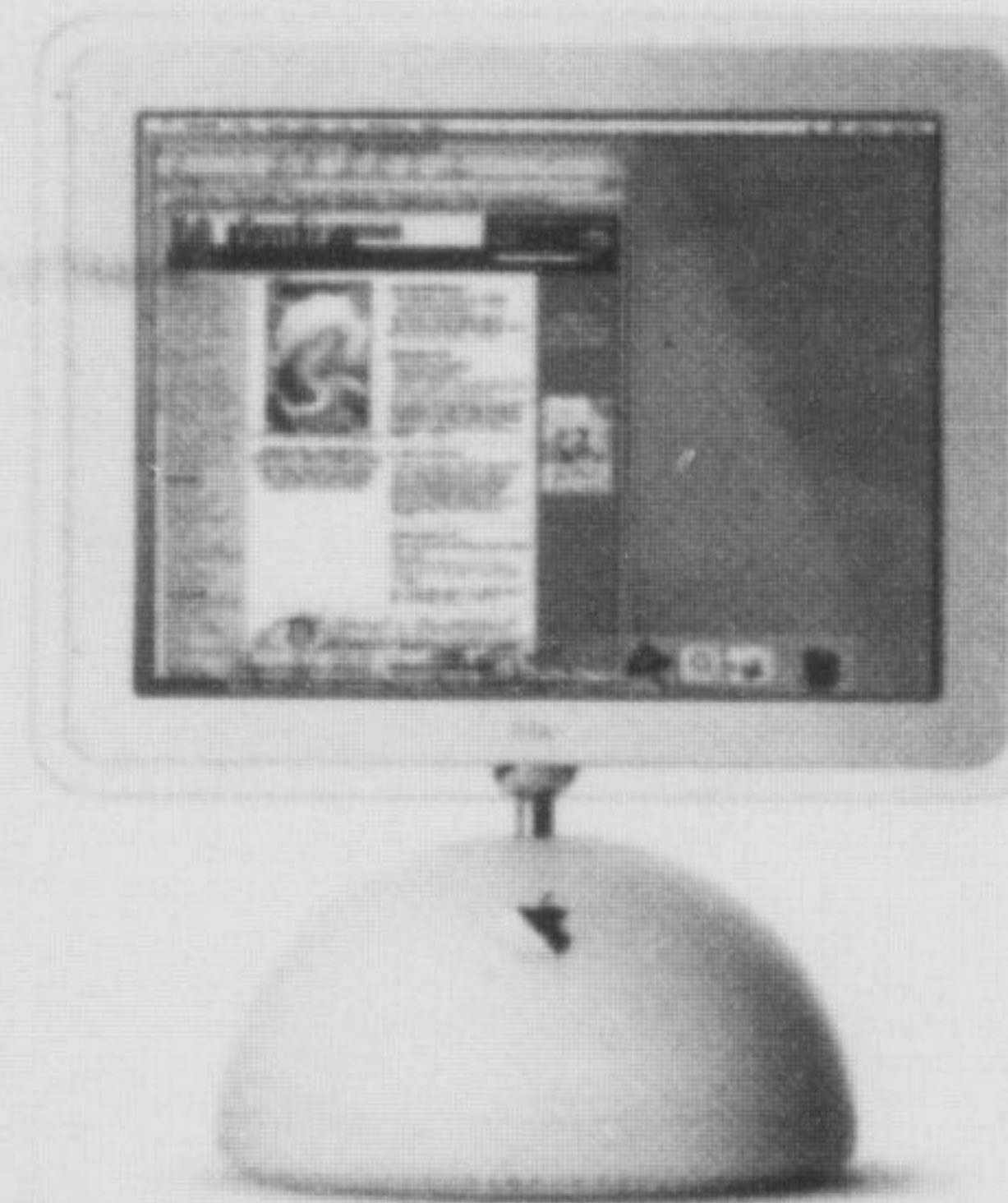
