Smile! It's cookie time.

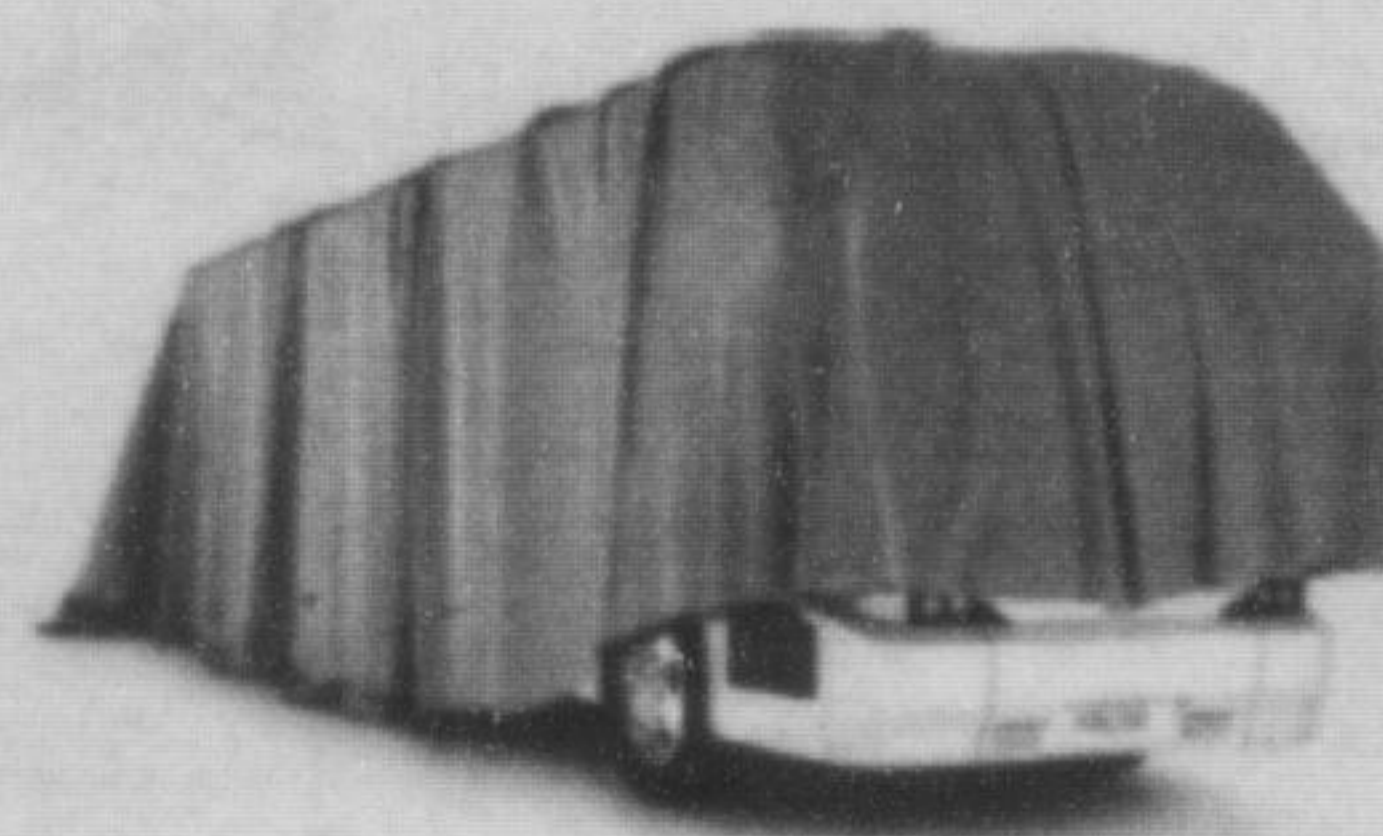
Tim Hortons is currently holding its annual Tim Hortons Smile Cookie campaign.
