A NEW MUNICIPAL CEMETERY IN HALTON HILLS

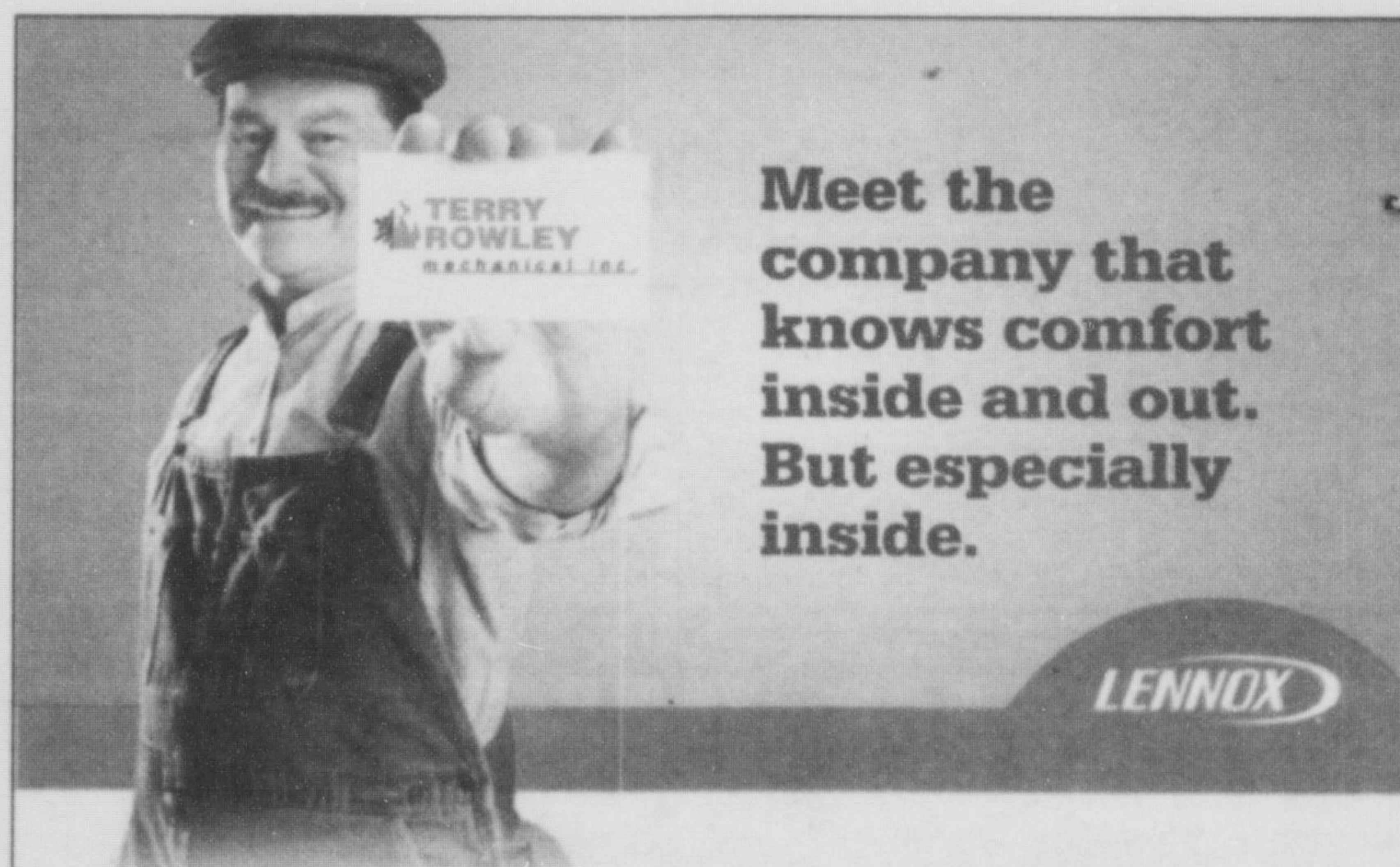
Devereaux Cemetery is now open, located at 12337 17th Side Road, just west of Trafalgar Road.
