The Tom Snow team at Re/Max and Dominion Lending Centre is going to give away some 75 real Christmas trees.

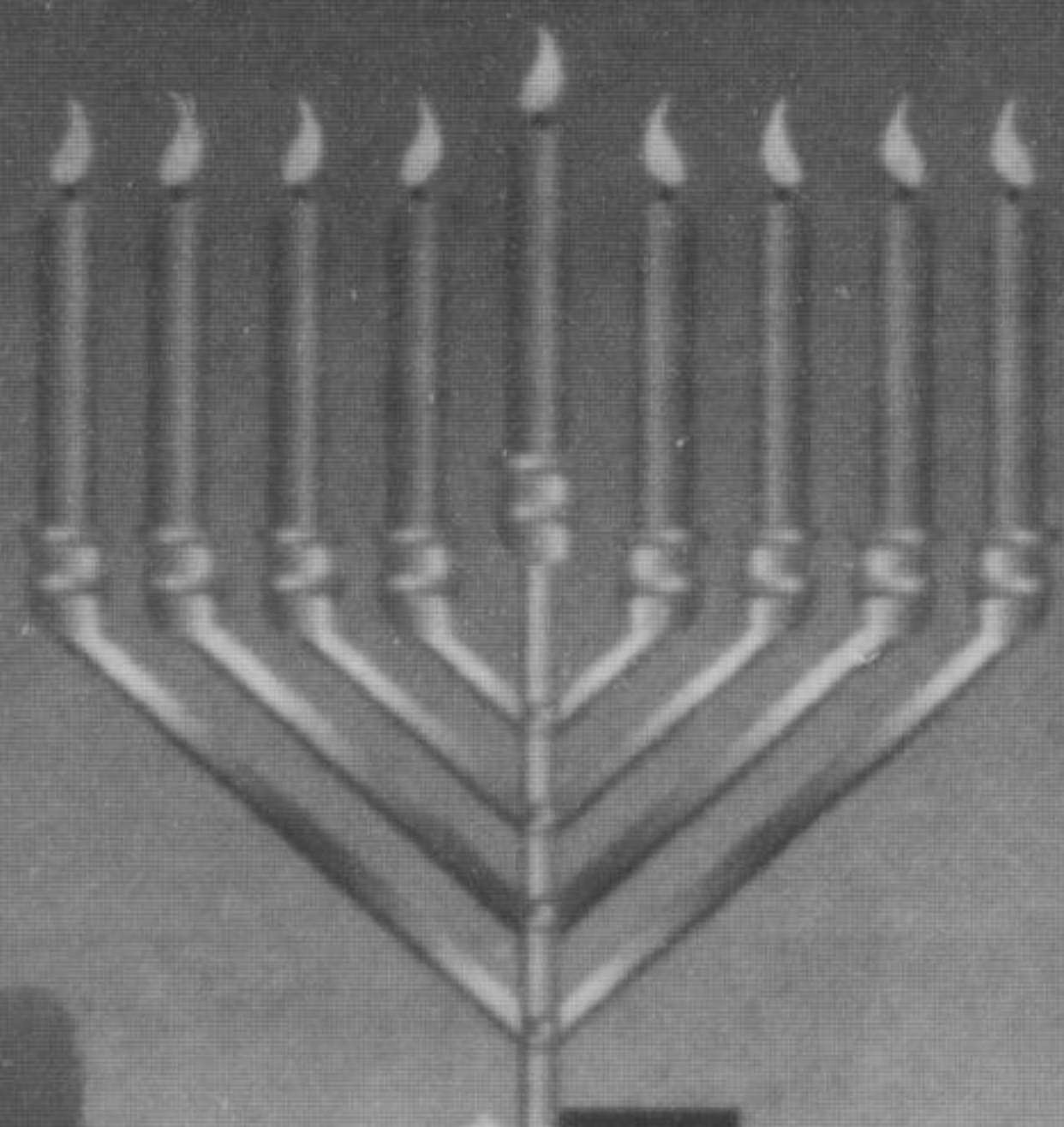
They're asking anyone who knows of a family in need to pass along the message.
