Jacob Lee knows all about having a family member diagnosed with breast cancer, with his cousin facing that scary scenario just last summer.

So when the chance to give back to Hamilton's Juravinski Cancer Centre — where his cousin underwent her treatment — presented itself, the young Miltonian jumped at it. Required to put together a fundraiser for one of his second-year business courses at Conestoga College, Lee decided to hold a bottle drive in support of the Juravinski

Cancer Centre.

He set a \$500 goal and is more than a third of the way toward that, hoping to make up the difference this Saturday with a door-to-door collection in the Bronte Street area of town between Derry Road and Main Street.

The drive will run from noon to 5 p.m.

place from 8:30 to 9:30 p.m. The event has been held since 2004 on the last Saturday in March, encouraging people, cities, towns, households and businesses to turn off non-essential lights for one hour. Neighbouring city of Toronto reported a 6 per cent reduction.



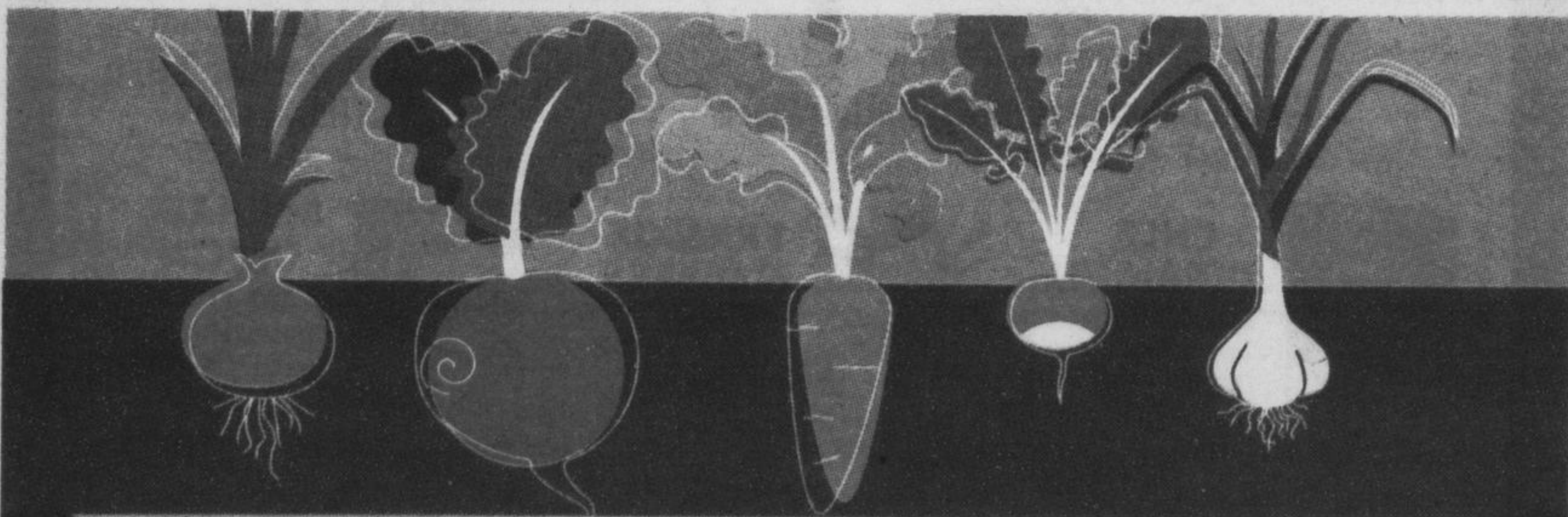
