Police seek public's help to identify suspect after indecent act

Halton police are hoping someone can help identify a suspect who exposed himself to a woman walking a dog in Rotary Park last week.

Police say a woman in her 50s was approached by a man April 9 around 11:30 a.m. He bent down to pet her dog. As he stood up, police say he exposed himself and was performing an indecent act on himself.

According to police, the woman struck the man with her cane several times, forcing him to flee in a vehicle.

The suspect is described as Spanish or of Middle Eastern decent, 20 years old, approximately 5-foot-8, with a slender build and short black hair cut straight across his forehead. He had a diamond stud earring in his left ear, and he was wearing a grey sweater or jacket, large pajama or 'balloon'-like pants that were either red/orange or pink. The car is grey and midsized.
