

Man charged in fatal crash

A 19-year-old Oakville man is facing charges in connection with the death of a Mississauga teen killed in a Milton car crash on March 16. Halton police said at around 1 a.m., a Pontiac Grand Prix was travelling southbound on Fifth Line when the driver lost control and the vehicle overturned and struck a hydro pole, coming to rest in a nearby field. Michael Piekny, 17, was pronounced dead at the scene. The driver and

two female passengers, all from Oakville, were rushed to hospital and have since been discharged. Tom Frankiewicz is charged with dangerous operation of a motor vehicle causing death and two counts of dangerous operation of a motor vehicle causing bodily harm. He's also charged under the Compulsory Automobile Insurance Act with operating a vehicle with no insurance.

Police would like to speak with witnesses

"You made everyone around you better people simply because the smiles you put on our faces. We love you bro so much." Luke Hesse posted, "Today, we all lost the most interesting man in the world. I don't think I've ever seen someone that you couldn't make smile and laugh! You're a hero and you were taken from us way to early."

Ben Stokes posted a picture of Scremin, under which he wrote, "One of a kind." Shannon Annabella commented on the photo, "What a beaut." Scremin is survived by his parents Gino and Josie and brothers Severino and Lorenzo. The funeral was held Monday at Holy Rosary Catholic Church. Police continue to investigate and

no charges have been laid at this time. Police would like to speak to anyone who may have seen the accident or the pick-up truck driving in the area of Bronte Street and Anne Boulevard prior to the incident.
