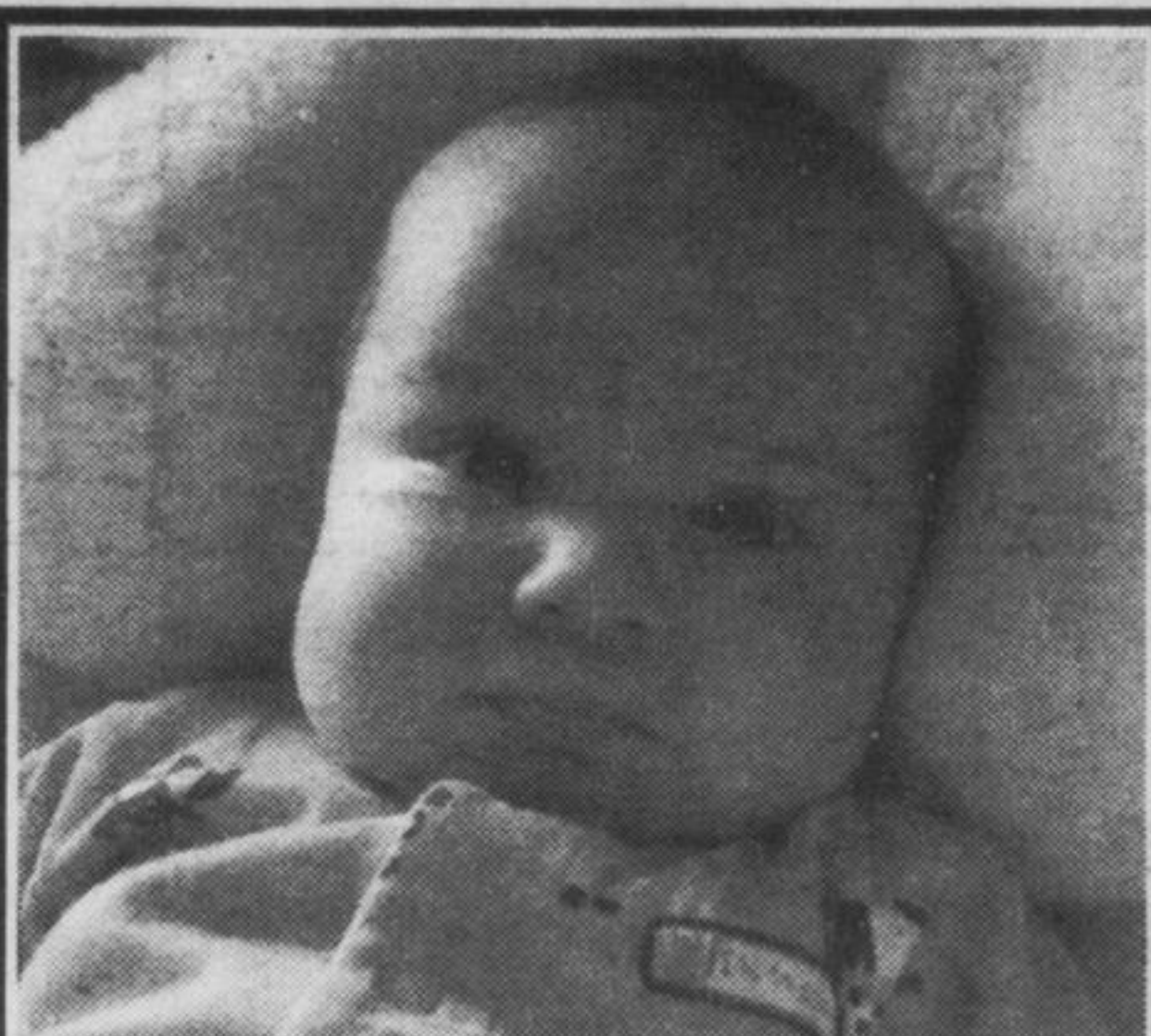

STOKES, Gloria, (Nee Hilson)

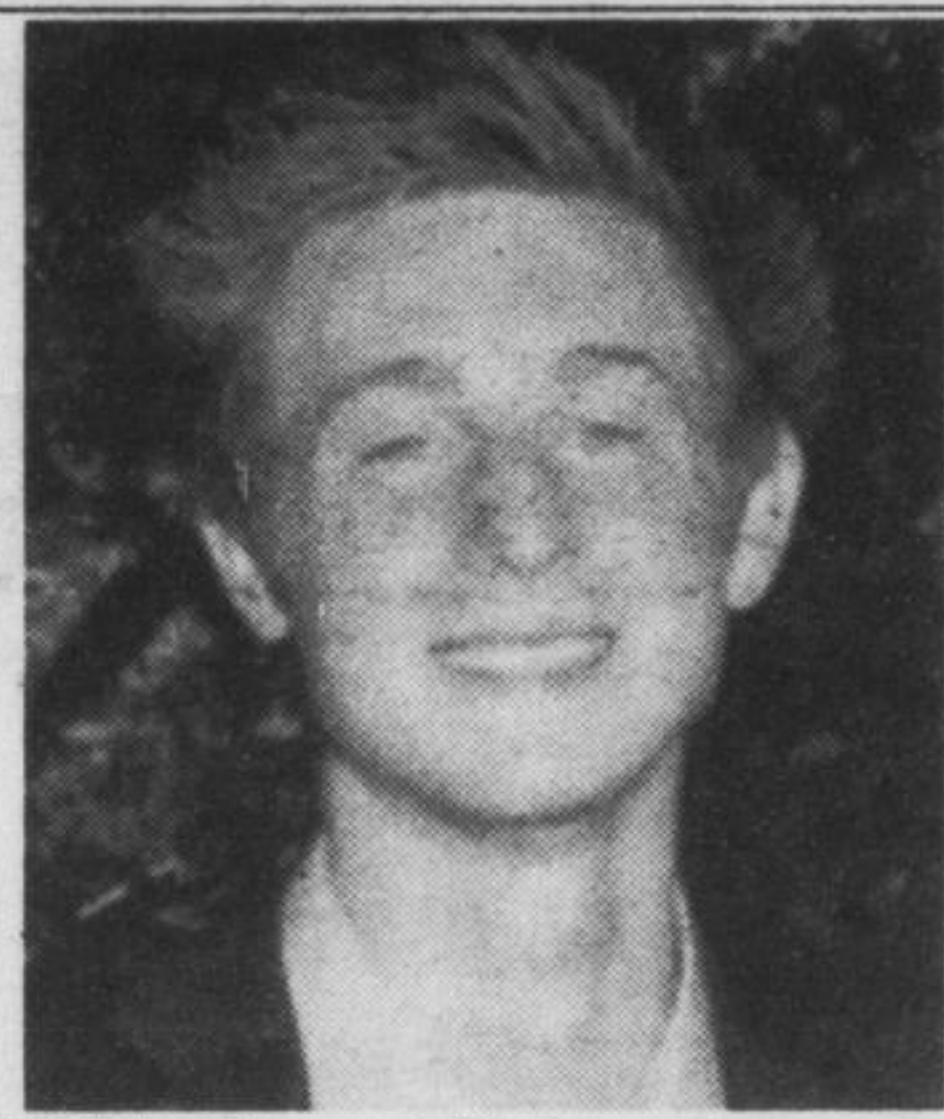

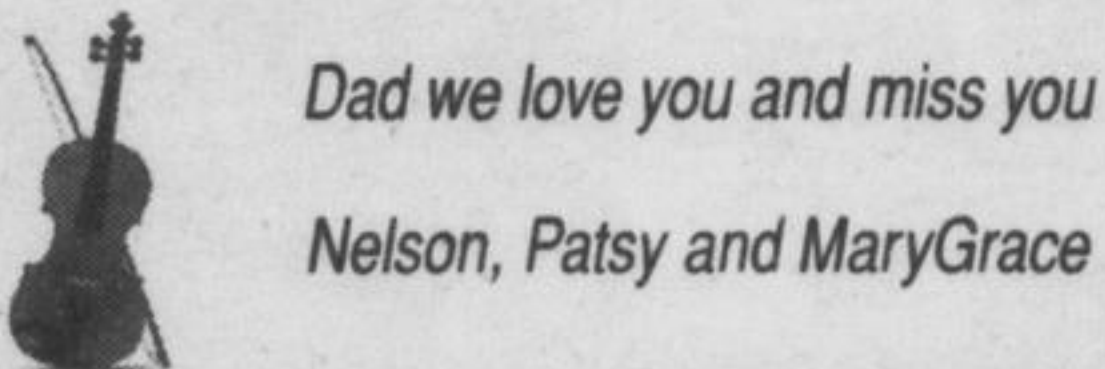
