



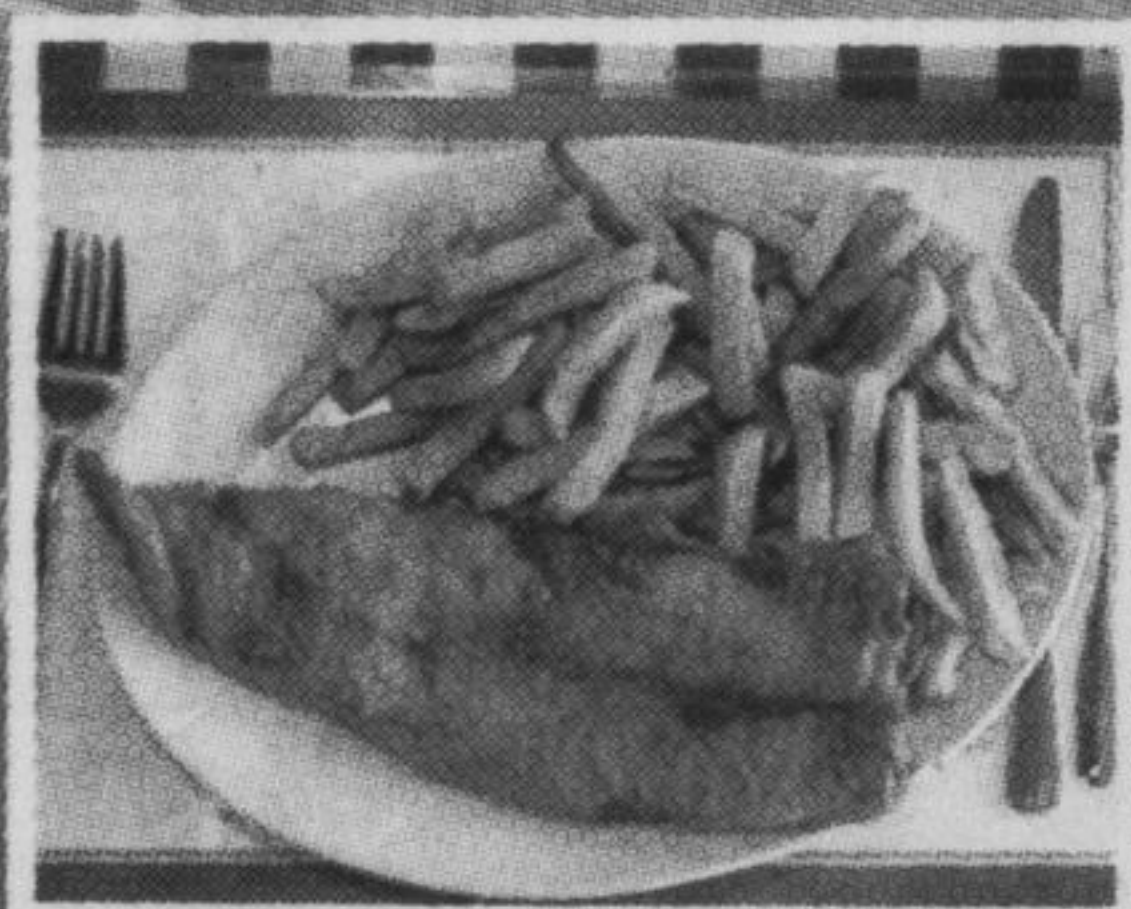
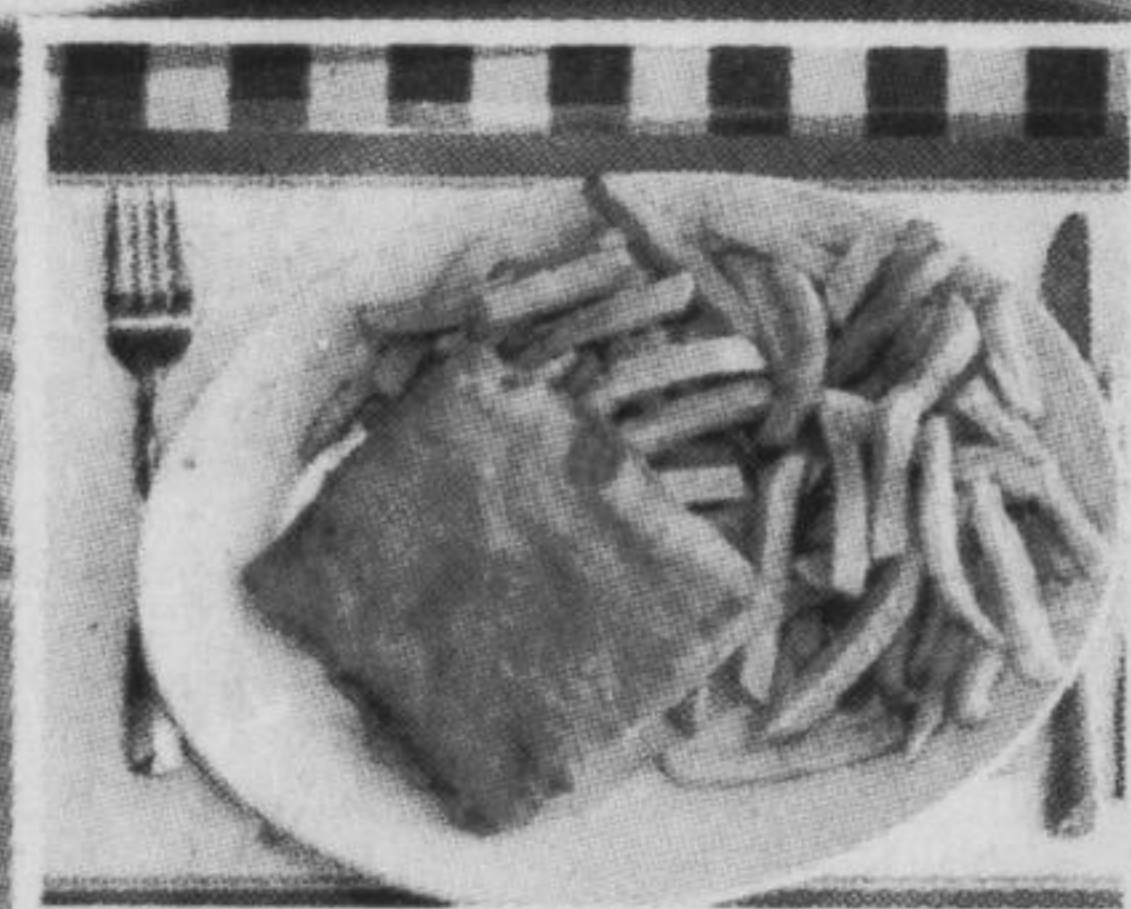
A day of creativity

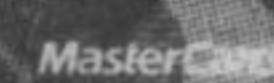
