

# Keep clean-up a breeze this barbecue season

- · Save trips back and forth to the kitchen. Use a sturdy tray or condiment caddy to carry your favourite toppings, cutlery and napkins in one trip.
- · Don't let spills and messes build up on the outside of your barbecue. As soon as the surface cools, spray it with barbecue-friendly cleaner and wipe with a paper towel. Do the same for any work surfaces and patio furniture.
- · Corn on the cob is a staple for many backyard meals, but removing the silk can be tough. Make it easy by running a moistened paper towel over the kernels after the husk has been removed.
- · Keep paper towels secure and within reach by attaching the holder to the bottom of a picnic table. Then, just pop in a roll as needed.
- Help create a non-stick surface and reduce the mess that's left behind after grilling by dipping a paper towel in a small amount of oil, holding it with metal tongs and carefully rubbing it over the barbecue grate.
