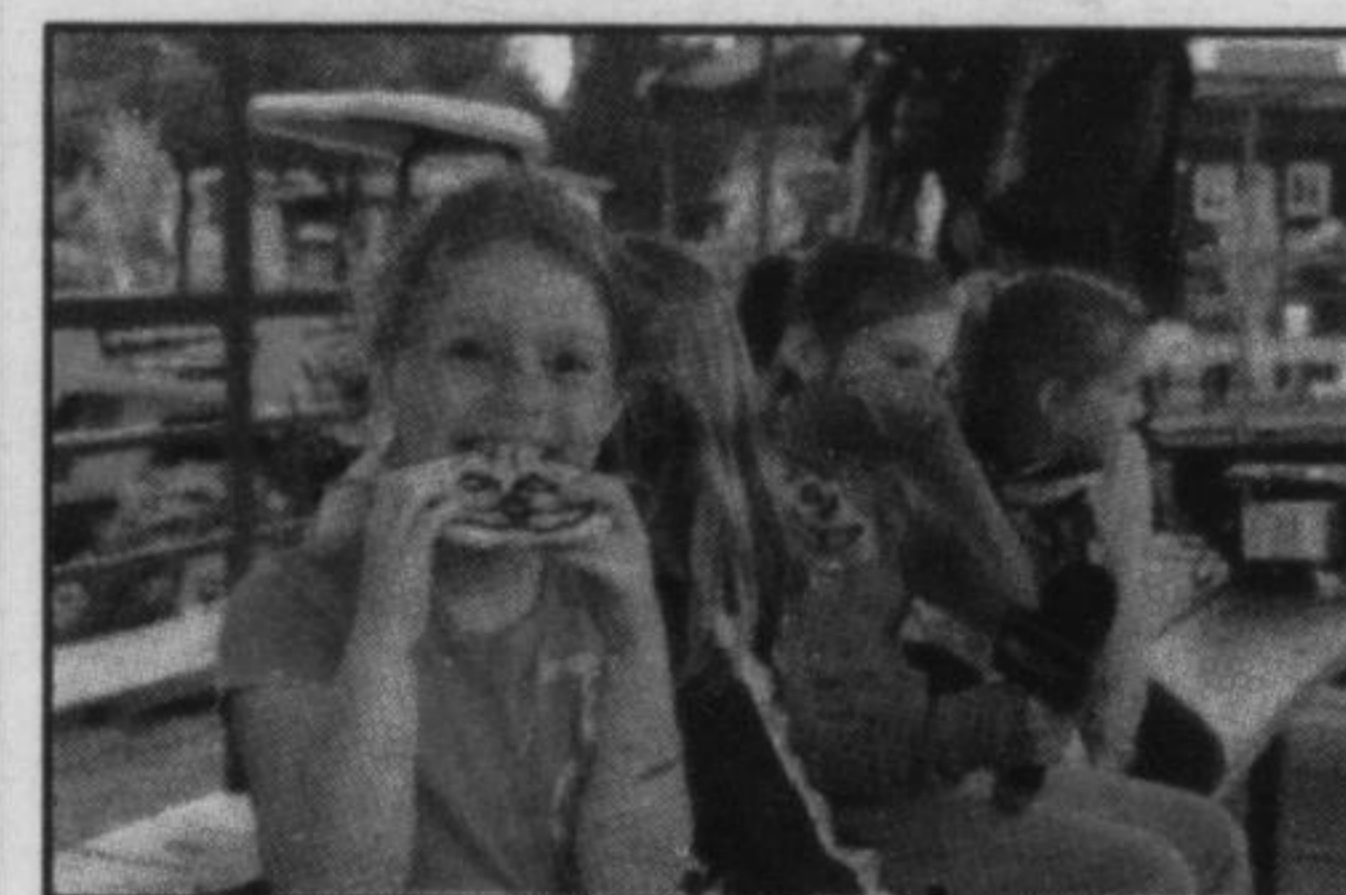
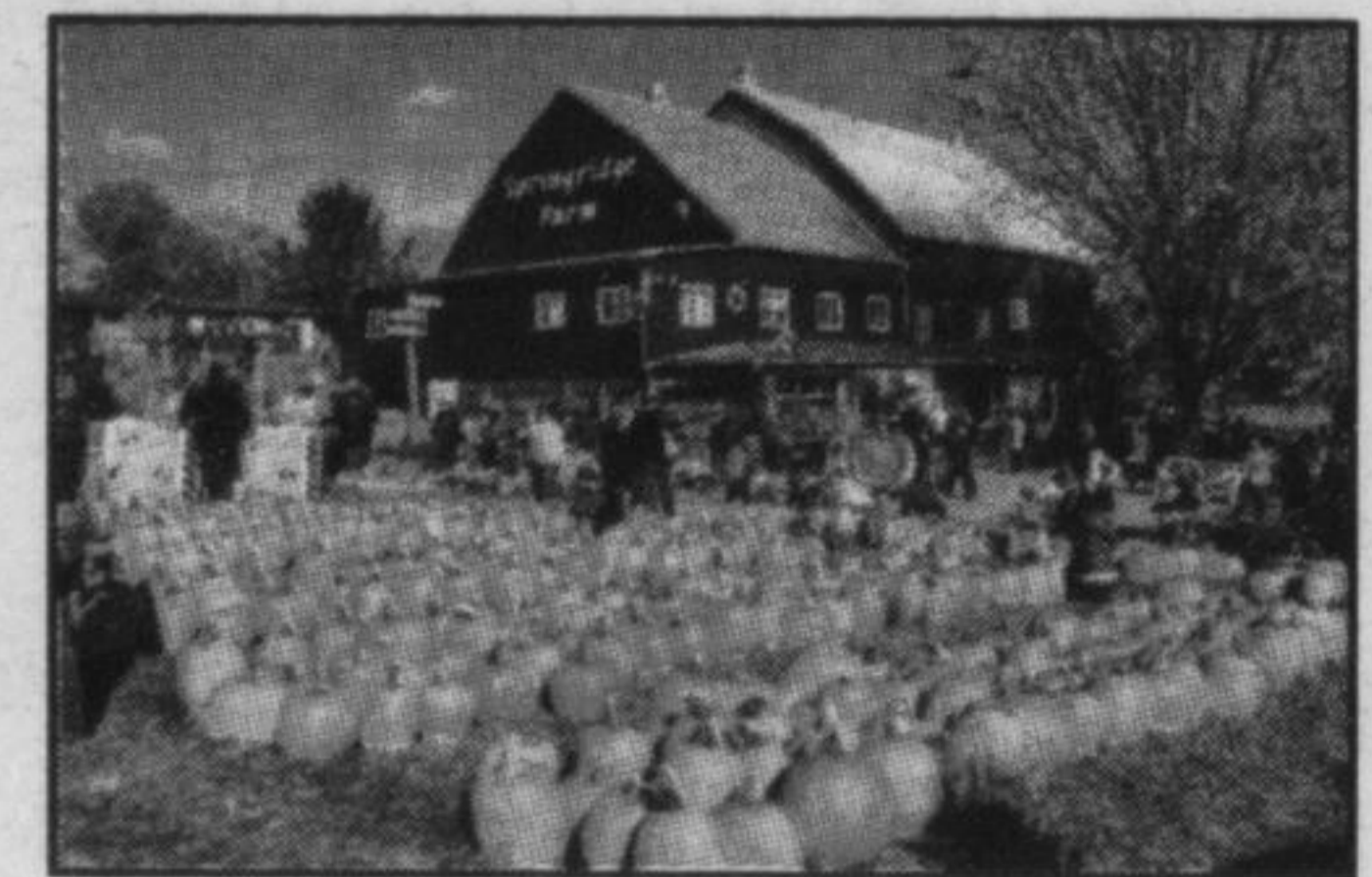

The word "pumpkin" was first used in the fairy tale Cinderella, written all the way back in the 17th century. It's no wonder the harvest season brings an enchanting feeling to Springridge Farm! Nestled alongside the changing leaves of the Niagara Escarpment, Springridge Farm grows endless fields of pumpkins in all shapes and sizes. From giant prize-winners and jack-o'-lanterns to jack-be-littles and ghosts, Farmer John's crop is truly something to celebrate.



Not only does Springridge Farm grow all the greatest pumpkins for fall decorating, they also incorporate them into their homemade baking. Their pumpkin pie is made from scratch in their farm kitchen using a special blend of spices. "Our pies are made from a time-honoured recipe that was passed along from Grandma Hughes," explains Laura Hughes, co-owner of Springridge Farm. "Pumpkin pie is a true symbol of our harvest season."

Freshly baked pumpkin muffins and jack-o'-lantern cookies are also featured in the bakery - all pair well with a steaming cup of apple cider.

Springridge Farm's annual Harvest Festival takes place every weekend (including Thanksgiving Monday) from Saturday, September 20 - Sunday, October 26, 2014. "Harvest Festival is all about autumn entertainment," says Farmer John. "It's fun to see families enjoying a day in the country." Harvest Festival activities include wagon rides, a giant corn trail, professional puppet show, spooky Boo Barn and the Fun Farm Yard. Admission to Harvest Festival is \$11 per person (including HST), ages 2-92.



Did you know Springridge Farm has their very own Pumpkin Princess? She is Cinderella's Fairy Godmother's niece and Elsa's second cousin once removed! She wanders the pumpkin patch every weekend during Harvest Festival and reigns over all the gourds and squashes. The Pumpkin Princess will always stop to pose for a photo with you too. Smile and say "pumpkin"!

This year's festival is kicking off with a special event featuring Celebrity Chef Stefano Faita. On Saturday, September 20 from 2-4pm, come to the farm for an exclusive meet and greet and cookbook signing.
