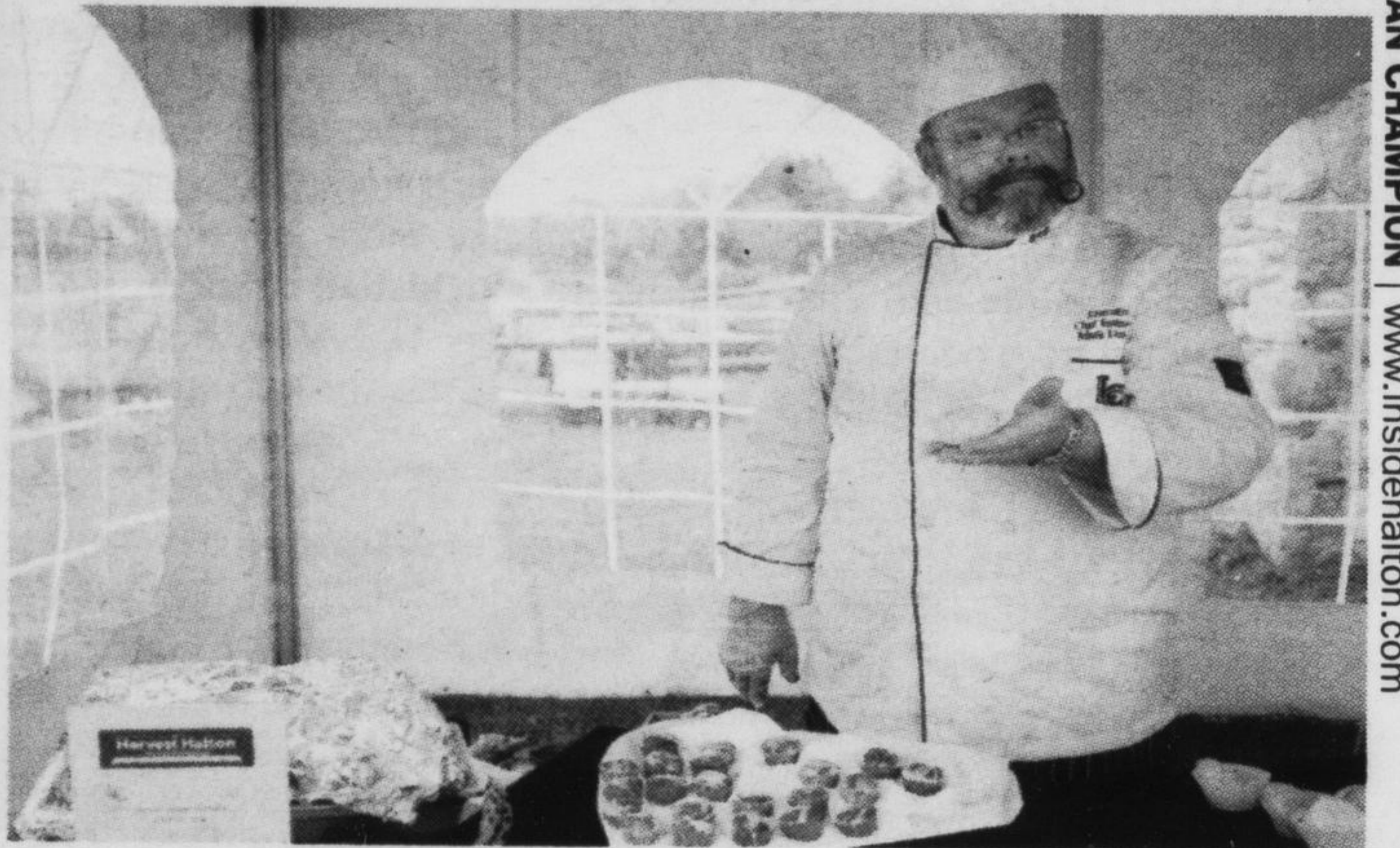


### Harvest time
