Lecture on 'The Giant's Rib' set

The Laurier Association for Lifelong Learning will host an illustrated lecture next week on one of the world's most unique geographical wonders — the Niagara Escarpment.

On Tuesday, retired Laurier instructor and escarpment expert Warren Stauch will educate and entertain through his lecture on what the First Nations of the area referred to as 'The Giant's Rib'.

The 700-km stretch of land contains more than 2,000 different species, including more endangered species than anywhere else in

Canada.

In 1990, the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) recognized the escarpment as a World Biosphere Reserve, making it one of only 16 in Canada.

The event will take place at 2 p.m. at the Milton Education Village Innovation Centre, 555 Industrial Dr. There's no cost to attend.
