

Participating in services good for young cadets, says Legion member

Legion Branch 136's public relations officer. "Their participation in the Poppy Campaign is a tribute to their parents, their schools and the cadet officers that teach and guide them. Legion member and former member of the Royal Dutch Marines, Casey Koelewyn, 83, agreed that participating in Remembrance Day events is good for the cadets, since many go on to become a part of the Canadian military.

Koelewyn, who made the big stained-glass window at the legion hall, has been an active

member of the Legion for six years, and has participated in every parade and Evergreen Cemetery service since joining.

He said he's happy with the ceremonies, but just wishes there would be more participants. "I would like to see a lot of our members following the parades and following the colour party," he said. "I wish a lot more members would come, even if they aren't in uniform, they could walk (in the parade) to show their support."

Once at the Victoria Park Cenotaph, there will be a wreath-laying ceremony and a Remem-

brance Day service, after which the parade will march back to the Legion hall, where everyone will be invited for lunch.

Blowe said she believes the parade is emotionally powerful.

"The outpouring of comradeship you feel during the services at the cenotaph are extremely moving," she said. "We are remembering not only those that fought in the world wars, but also those that fought in

all the wars and in peacekeeping. We must never forget. It is everyone's responsibility to remember those that served and to honour those that serve today and those that will in the future."

The parade will start at 1:30 p.m. and should reach the Victoria Park Cenotaph by 2 p.m. The service at Evergreen Cemetery, 190 Ontario St. S., on Tuesday, Nov. 11 will start at 11 a.m.
