

# Town's next Senior of the Year sought, nominations now being accepted

The Town of Milton is seeking nominations for the Senior of the Year award. The award is presented to a senior who has contributed to Milton's community in a number of areas, including arts and literature, volunteerism, humanitarian activities, science, education, fitness, recreation or sport, the en-

vironment, or keeping history alive. Winners will receive a certificate of recognition from the Province and a lifetime pass for Milton Transit. The nominee must be 65 or older and a current resident of Milton for at least one year. They must also not have previously won the award. The winner will be acknowledged

at the June town council meeting, coinciding with Seniors' Month. Nomination forms can be found on the Town's website at [www.milton.ca](http://www.milton.ca). Those submitting nominations must describe how the senior fits the criteria and why they should win. There must also be three letters of reference.

Household waste collection takes place as usual on New Year's Eve (Wednesday, December 31). There is no household waste collection on New Year's Day (Thursday, January 1). Due to the holiday, household waste collection will take place the day after your regular collection day.

Please place your waste at the curb by 7 a.m. on your scheduled holiday collection day.

### Garbage Tag Exemption

Your first garbage collection day after Christmas Day (December 25) will **not** require garbage tags; however, the **six garbage bag/can limit applies**.
