## Each short film to be screened before one of main feature films

The festival's selection committee, which includes Milton author and former *Toronto Star* film critic Ron Base, reviewed 13 short films submitted by professional, amateur and student filmmakers from across the GTA and as far away as Vancouver and Regina.

"We decided to open things up a little this year and accept films from outside Ontario as well," said Jennifer Smith, the festival's director and committee chair. "One submission, Running By, about a farmer's son trying to live out his passion for running, was created by the nephew of one of our volunteers. Bryce Gamache is from Manitoba and lives in Saskatchewan, but we were so impressed with his work that we couldn't say no." The other selections are:

Bamboozled, directed by Mike Martins
A group of students decide to pull a con
game at school. But who's conning whom?
This film was made by and with the students

in the Grade 8 Film Club at Divine Mercy of School in Mississauga. The students comprised both the cast and crew of the production.

Religatio, directed by Jaime Giraldo
Beings who live in a world hanging from ropes are all engaged in a struggle to avoid falling into the void below. Produced at the Vancouver Film School, Religatio is Jaime's most recent animation. He's currently living in Newfoundland.

A Mile In These Hooves, directed by

Mark and Tom walk from Toronto to L.A. in a two-person donkey costume, competing for the title of 'longest distance travelled in a two-person costume'. It's a "mockumentary" about love, friendship and a burlap donkey.
